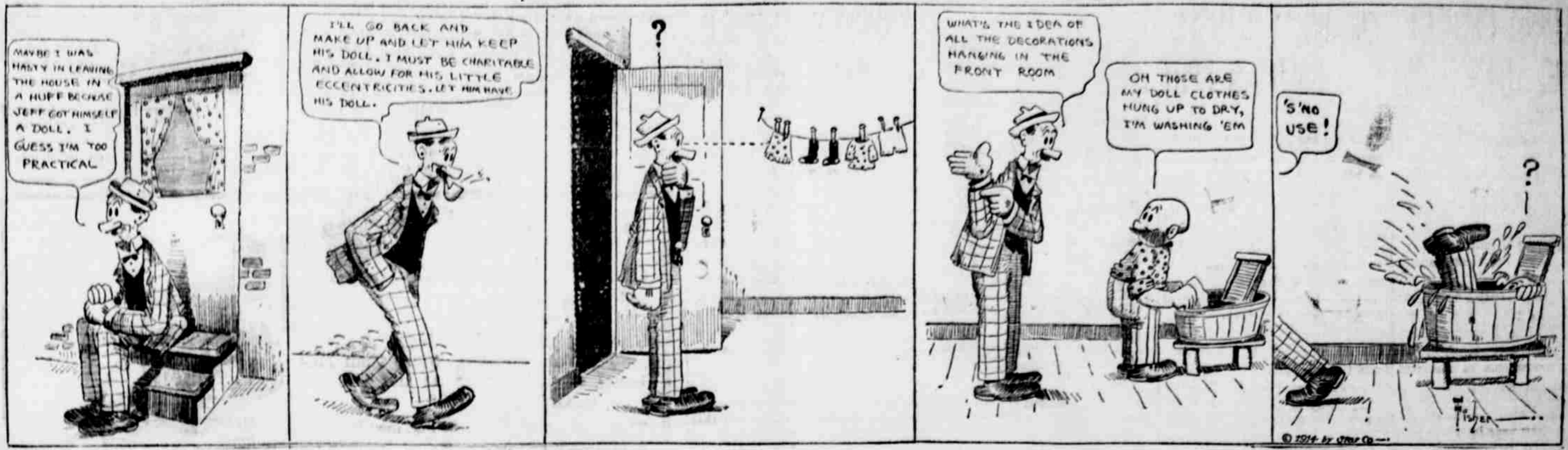


# And Jeff Couldn't Even Wait Till Monday for Wash Day
