

GOLD LEDGE FOUND ON GRIZZLY PEAK

The uncovering of what is believed to be an extensive ledge of gold-bearing ore on the slopes of Old Grizzly was one of the surprises of the past week.

The samples brought to Ashland are highly mineralized and bear resemblance to the ore taken from the Homestake mine in South Dakota and the ore at Cripple creek.

The discoverer of the ore body is J. E. Hummel, who says he has lived over in that section for years and has known of the ledge for a long time, but never had the money to work it.
