leaving was that Huerta planned to strip the embassy of guns in retaliation for the loss of Vera Cruz. He had already seized the railroads and telegraph and refused to allow O'Shaughnessy, Captain Burnside, the embassy's military attache, or Consul General Shanklin to send on messages.

"All I want," O'Shaughnessy said the last time I saw him, "is to get the embassy out of here."

Members of the house of deputies led the mob which rioted in front of the American club after the news of Vera Cruz's capture was received. The news of the landing of the marines reached the people through extra editions of the newspapers. The dictator seemed to be doing everything possible to inflame the crowds and he succeeded.

Danger at Guadalupe

The 500 Americans at Guadalupe probably are in as great danger as those in Mexico City, as anti-American sentiment will be permitted to run rampant until Huerta's anger is satisfied. He has a double purpose in this—revenge for the loss of Vera Cruz and furtherance of his policy to force a general conflict with the United States.

The dictator is using every means to raise troops and funds. He is making paper money galore. A guard of soldiers is stationed over the American printing office where it is being printed.

Over the Tampico incident Huerta and O'Shaughnessy had a verbal fight in the street in full view of the public.

Of this I was able to get out no news as the censor rejected all the messages I filed with the exception of the despatch telling of Huerta's desire for war and the occupation of Vera Cruz, which being so coded as to conceal their real meaning, he considered insignificant.

Here is how Huerta dealt with the question on which hinged peace or war:

He left home early, he did not go to the palace and he did not leave word where he could be found.

O'Shaughnessy, receiving long telegraphic instructions from Washington, started out to find him, making the rounds of the Cafe Colon, where the dictator habitually takes his morning cognac, as well as of other cafes which he occasionally visits.

He found him at the Jockey Club bar.

"Have you your automobile outside?" asked Huerta.

"Yes," answered O'Shaughnessy, "my new one."

"Let's sit there," said Huerta.

The pair got into the car, which stood in a side street. Huerta's bodyguard and his attendants withdrew, and for three quarters of an hour he and O'Shaughnessy argued.

A photographer who tried to take a picture of them was driven away.

O'Shaughnessy spoke smilingly; Huerta vehemently, frequently smashing a fist into the palm of his hand. He was sober at the time.

O'Shaughnessy said later:

In the event of a crisis the dictator is prepared to escape. His plan is to announce that he is going to the front, take with him a small bodyguard of troops known as the
