Mr. Bennett has recently passed through the war ridden zone of Northern Mexico and states that it will be a year before mining can get started in Mexico again while on the other hand there is rapid improvement in the mining outlook in Western America.

Criticising mining as it is con ducted in many parts of the west, he stated that if mine owners and operators would employ technically trained mining engineers more, there would be less money lost and fewer mistakes made. Mining, he says, has come to be a scientific business and that all the losses that have ever been experienced in mining have originated in trying to treat it as otherwise.
