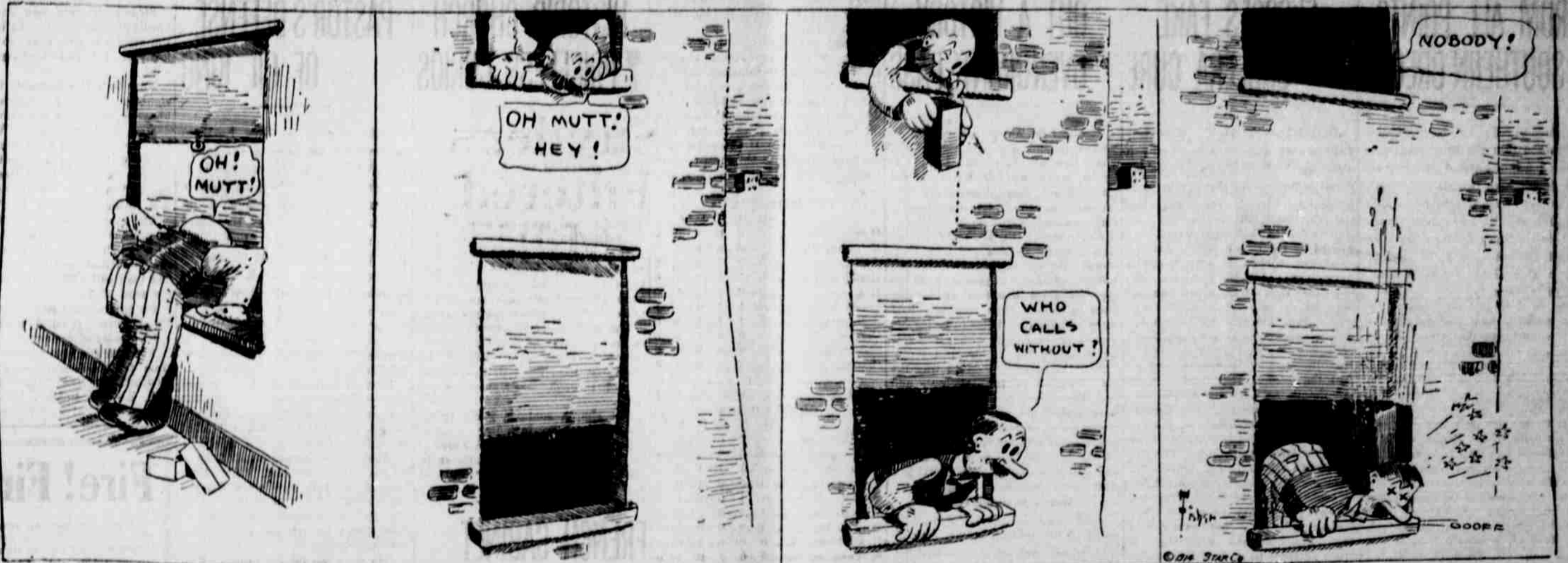

GERMAN SHIPS FINED MILLION PESOS FOR LANDING ARMS

WASHINGTON, June 1.—Secretary Garrison made an official statement today of the status of the cases of the German ships Ypiranga and Bavaria, which landed munitions of war for Huerta at Puerto Mexico, and were fined more than a million pesos by American officials at Vera Cruz. General Funston reported the ships' agents had arranged bonds. The secretary's statement follows: "The customs and port officials fined the Hamburg-American liner Bavaria 11,865 pesos for having discharged a large portion of her cargo, consigned to Vera Cruz, at another port before arriving at the port of Vera Cruz, and for correcting her manifest after arrival in port. "A similar fine has been imposed upon the Ypiranga amounting to 94,850 pesos for failure to correct invoices accordingly and discharging her cargo at a port other than that to which consigned. General Funston states the officials in question had no option under the Mexican law and had to assess the fines in the sums named. No appeal has been taken on behalf of the vessels, and the presumption is that if any further proceedings are to be had, representations will be made to our state department. "Concerning sanitary conditions at Vera Cruz, Secretary Garrison said: "The United States has completed one month's occupancy of Vera Cruz. There has been ashore more than 7000 soldiers and marines, and not one death from disease has occurred within that period."

FEDERAL TROOPS AT SAN LUIS POTOSI

MEXICO CITY, June 1.—Many trains conveying the federal troops which formed the garrison of Saltillo, were arriving all day yesterday, at San Luis Potosi, according to dispatches from that city today. A federal detachment under General Pascual Orozco, Jr., acted as a rear guard, and as the army proceeded southward, destroyed the railroad so as to prevent a further advance by the constitutionalists. IDENTIFICATION OF EMPRESS VICTIMS PROCEEDS RAPIDLY

QUEBEC, June 1.—Identification of the dead from the scene of the wreck of the Canadian Pacific steamer Empress of Ireland is proceeding more rapidly than was expected. Nearly 100 of the 188 bodies brought here yesterday by the tender Lady Grey have been recognized by friends and relatives. This is an addition to the ten bodies identified and claimed at Rimouski. Identifications include Sir Henry Seton-Karr, the big game hunter; Dr. E. A. Barlow, a leading geologist of Canada, and Mrs. W. Leonard Palmer, wife of a London newspaper man. Nearly a score of members of the Salvation Army have been identified. The Lady Grey, escorted by the British warship Essex, arrived in Quebec early yesterday morning, and soon thereafter bluejackets from the Essex were carrying the coffins ashore. The bodies were placed on long tables, draped in black and white, in the shed which had been prepared for their reception. The pier shed was heavily draped in black, and over the window sheets were fastened to shut out the view of the curious and morbid. On the wharf was a throng of officials, newspaper men, photographers and moving picture men, while outside a sorrowing crowd awaited admittance to search for their dead. A section in the shed that caused deep sorrow to those who visited it was that in twenty-five little caskets lay. These contained the bodies of babes and children. Person after person turned away, crying.

M. P. HENDERSON IS SELECTED PATHOLOGIST

At a mass meeting of the orchardists of the Rogue River valley Saturday afternoon M. P. Henderson, of the University of Wisconsin, was recommended for county pathologist, subject to the final approval of the county court. The meeting was a very successful one, over eighty orchardists were in it. It was decided to form a Farmers and Fruitgrowers league and the following officers and board of directors were elected for the year: W. A. Sumner, president; Dr. Henry Hart, vice president; J. S. Villas, vice-president; E. W. Carlton, secretary, and C. A. Knight, treasurer. Directors to serve for one year: J. A. Perry, H. W. Bingham, A. C. Allen, Victor Payne and J. A. Westlund. Directors to serve for two years: C. M. Thomas, Bert Anderson, H. B. Tronson, R. B. Wilson and R. H. Parsons. Directors to serve for three years: S. V. Beckwith, W. V. H. Campbell, E. B. Hanley, G. B. Carpenter and R. C. Washburn. At the next meeting the officers and directors will perfect the organization. The purpose of the league is to unite the farmers and orchardists to put them in a position to act as a body instead of individuals when their various problems come up. The organization will not deal exclusively with fruit problems but with all questions which affect the orchardists welfare such as good roads, taxes, competent officials, etc., etc. The officers and directors will meet later and decide upon the name

of the organization and constitution and by-laws. O. A. C. co-operates with the orchardists and the county in paying the expenses of the pathologist.
