

## BOTH BIG SMOKE AND MORAN SURE OF WINNING BATTLE

PARIS, June 26.—Both Jack Johnson, heavyweight champion of the world, and Frank Moran of Pittsburgh, challenger for the title, finished their training today and each of them declared himself in the best possible condition for their contest tomorrow night.

"I shall win sure," was the telegram Johnson sent to his mother in Chicago, while a friend of Moran who visited him at his training quarters at Meriel on the Oise, said that the challenger was no less confident.

The advance sale of seats indicated there will be a great crowd at the Velodrome d'Hiver when the fight starts at 10:30 o'clock tomorrow night.

It is understood that many women have purchased tickets, some of whom never miss any important boxing match in Paris.

The poor of Paris will realize a good sum as the result of the contest as it is calculated that the receipts will reach at least \$100,000 and according to the law, 10 per cent is added to the price of each ticket for the benefit of the poor.

No better date could have been selected for the fight, as it occurs on the eve of the Grand Prix, the principal sporting event of the year and in the height of the tourist season, when many Americans and other foreigners are in Paris.

The selections of George Carpenter, the French champion, as referee is also considered likely to draw a large following, as he is an idol among the Parisians.

## FRUIT GROWERS OF WESTERN OREGON JOIN DISTRIBUTORS

SPOKANE, Wash., June 26.—Fruitgrowers' association of Western Oregon were federated into one big district organization which in turn will be affiliated with the North Pacific Fruit Distributors this week, following a meeting of delegates held in Portland last Saturday. The new association will be incorporated as the Western Oregon Distributors, with headquarters in Portland. It will be the ninth sub-central organization of the North Pacific Fruit Distributors, the co-operative central selling agency, already representing over 60,000 growers for marketing their fruit.

The Portland meeting was attended by about 50 growers' delegates and was held in the Portland Commercial club rooms. Associations in eight localities joined the new Western Oregon branch at that time—those

Two others were represented which are already affiliated with the distributors but which in all probability will become a part of the new district: they are at White Salmon and Underwood, Wash. In the eight new localities which have availed themselves and become a part of the distributors' marketing machine, there are between 2500 and 3000 growers at Sutherlin, Eugene, Corvallis, New-

Delegates also attended from Dunsmuir, Dallas, Albany, Grants Pass and Medford, Ore., who were not formally authorized by their associations to join the distributors at that time although considerable interest is manifested in the proposal by the growers in their respective sections and such action may be taken within the near future.
