### TURKEY CLAIMS RUSSIAN REPULSE ON SECOND LINE

BERLIN, Nov. 13, (by wireless.)—Included in the information given to the press today from official quarters is the following:

"Reports received here from Constantinople set forth that the Turkish army in the Caucasus is taking the Russians on their second line of defense. An artillery engagement near Koeprory on November 4, lasted all day long.

"The Persian, Afghan, Egyptian, Indian and Mohammedan elements in Constantinople have declared the community of their interests. The Sunnites and the Shites (two opposing religious sects), are now for the first time, ready for joint action.

"The Vossische Zeitung reports that Roumania has declined a demand made by Russia for the passage of Russian troops through Roumanian territory.

"The London Times has published a statement to the effect that the British government has undertaken legal action against certain Irish newspapers for having opposed recruiting in Ireland."

### FUNDS TO FIGHT FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE ARE LOW

WASHINGTON, Nov. 13.—Available money for fighting foot and mouth disease is getting low and officials of the department of agriculture are confronted with a perplexing situation. Lack of funds is hampering the department, and when congress reassembles in December a special appropriation probably will be asked.

Scarcity of funds has forced the department to economize and instructions have gone out to field agents to save herds wherever the disease develops in only a few animals. Half of the expense of slaughtering is borne by the federal government.

The only money available is an appropriation of \$600,000 made by congress last year for inspection and quarantine work. This is almost exhausted.

PARIS, Nov. 13, 3:55 a. m.—A special from Dunkirk states that a French torpedo boat sank a German submarine off Westende, Belgium.

The submarine, it appears, was trying to torpedo the French warship when the latter's commander caught sight of her periscope, put on full speed and charged down on the enemy, which disappeared.

A large quantity of oil rose to the surface, marking the spot where the submarine sank.

The torpedo boat received only slight damage and returned to port for repairs.
