

"OLD WOMAN OF THE ALLEYS" IS BURIED AGAIN

CHICAGO, Dec. 22.—Jane Irving, who for years was known as "The Old Woman of the Alleys," will be buried for the second time today.

Funeral services were held for her in the Episcopal cathedral of Santa Peter and Paul and Charles P. Anderson, Episcopal bishop of Chicago and Dean Walter Taylor Sumner, who is to be bishop of Oregon next month, officiated. It was through Dean Sumner, to whom Jane left her property, four trunks and the boxes—when she was committed to the asylum, that her money was revealed.

Search of the trunks disclosed her will. Bankbooks found in the boxes, which contained hundreds of packages, showed that she had deposited \$115.00 in Chicago. The will bequeathed the money to the diocese of Chicago to provide a decent burial to women of the poorhouse.
