QUEENSTOWN, May 7.—The Lusitania's wireless call for assistance was received here at 2:15 o'clock. Admiral Coke dispatched all available tugs and steam trawlers to the scene.

It is believed here that her passengers are safe. No details of how they may have been rescued, is at hand. One message received here says it is not known how many of the Lusitania's passengers were saved.

Work on the new federal building is being delayed by the non arrival and acceptance of brick by the government. It is expected the situation will be relieved next week.
