SECRETARY OLCOTT FATHER OF TWIN BOYS

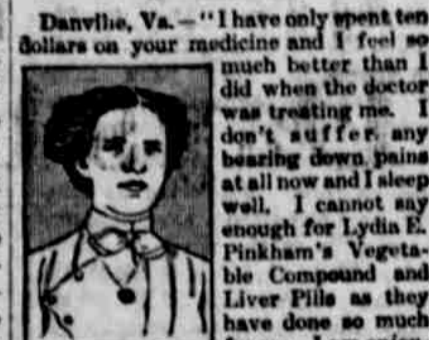
