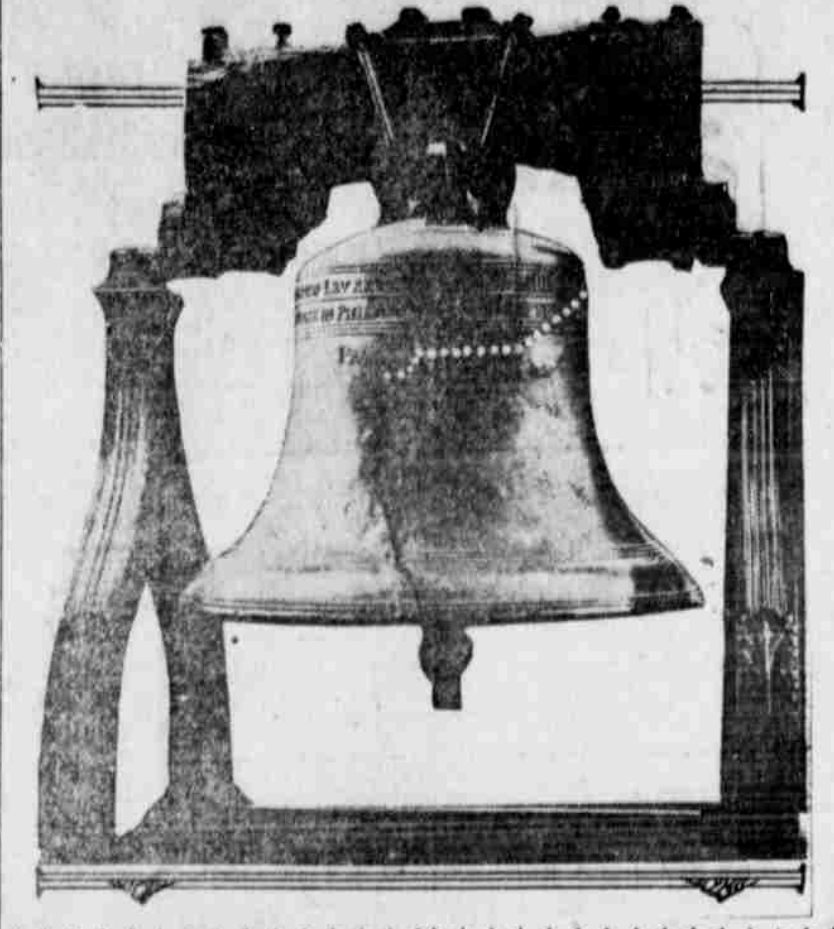

To the Editor: As you have no doubt noticed through the press reports, Clatsop and Columbia counties have settled, through compromise, their differences with the contractors who have been constructing highways through the said counties.

CHAUTAQUA AT ASHLAND OPENS FINE PROGRAM

ASHLAND, July 6.—The twenty-third session of the southern Oregon Chautauqua assembly began here tonight July 6, inclusive. The program includes a wealth of talent in every department.

Headliners on the rostrum are Newell Dwight Hillis, George W. Bam, Nels Durbin, B. R. Damngarat, Rev. Father MacCurry, Roland A. Nichols and others. Musical treats will be offered by the Gallota Trio, the Graus Yodlers, Saxony Singers, Mac Donald, the baritone, Cirillo's Italian Band and the Solomon Quintet. "Il Trovatore" in costume will be rendered by the Thaxin grand opera singers just as given in the great cities. The Floyd family will afford specialties in magic, and Professor Larmore will be on hand with his "eirens."

Segregated by days, Ohio day will be Tuesday, July 6; Central Point and Gold Hill, July 7; W. C. T. U., July 8; New York, July 9; Ashland, July 10, the program including a lecture on "Our Town," by Nelson Darling, a topic exceedingly apropos, with a grand concert by the Schumann's, Fellowship day, July 11, with a fine sermon, and musical accompaniments by the Saxony Singers in sacred concert in the evening. Medford day, Monday, July 12, with two great concerts by the famous Italian band of thirty pieces, under the leadership of Signor Salvatore Cirillo, and "Il Trovatore," by the Thaxin grand concert company. Jacksonville day, July 13; Talent and Phoenix, July 14; the Southland day, July 15. The session to conclude with Circus day on Friday, July 16.

OREGON SHOWS SLIGHT INCREASE IN GOLD OUTPUT

WASHINGTON, July 6.—Very few changes in the mining conditions in Oregon are noted by Chas. G. Yale, of the U. S. Geological Survey, for the first six months of the year. The mint and smelters at San Francisco show only about \$15,000 increase of gold receipts in the first five months of 1915 over the same period in 1914.

The Powder River Dredging company, at Sumpter, the most productive placer mine in the state, is building an additional dredge. The North Pole mine, in Cracker creek district, non-productive for some time, will shortly again be producing. It has a large territory only partly opened, but recent developments show strikes of good ore. A railroad is being built from Grants Pass into the Waldo copper district, in Josephine county, and these mines will then be given an opportunity to ship their ores to a smelter. Prospecting is rather inactive in the state as capital is scarce to develop even the known properties.

The most important productive mines of the state continue to be the following: Among the deep mines, The Rainbow Commercial Mining Co., and the Cornucopia Mines Co., located in Baker county, are the largest two producers. The Rainbow mine is in the Mormon Basin district and the Cornucopia mine is in the Cornucopia district. Other prominent producers in Baker county are the Columbia Gold Mines Co., at Sumpter, Cracker creek district, and the Baker Mines Co., in the Cornucopia district. Outside of Baker county the Ben Harrison mine of Grant county, and the Humbolt Cons. Gold mines of the valley, Mormon Basin, Malheur county, are the only large producers. The most important placer mines are the Powder River Dredge Co., Cracker creek district, Baker county, (the leading dredge mine), The Osmond mine, Waldo district, Josephine county, and the Layton, Applegate district, Jackson county, are the leading hydraulic mines. As before, the dredge mining is far in excess of any other form of placer mining in Oregon, and hydraulic and drift mining being the next in importance. Baker county continues to be the largest producing county.
