What Irrigation Will Cost

is an important and vital question. We unfortunately have a certain figure per acre set in our minds as the price that water will cost us because we have talked that figure so long that we believe it ourselves. We may be wrong! It might cost less! It might cost more! For some time after the delivery of irrigation from any project is a settled fact, the important question will be: What will irrigation cost us ANNUALLY? How much must we pay this year? and next year? If the payment plan is reasonable and self-supporting and enables us to make a profit over and above annual charges we would all be satisfied.

Certainly Today, Price Is Not the Most Important Question,

Because we have no price offered us, and if it were offered a string would be attached to it "PROVIDING SO-AND-SO MANY THOUSAND ACRES ARE SIGNED." And we know that this is a fair proviso, because it is the question that we are up against Ourselves! On any irrigation project the price to deliver any amount of water at all will obviously involve, as intimated yesterday on this page, a certain fixed amount of money. This amount must be equally distributed over the 10,000 or 15,000 or 20,000 or 25,000 acres that want irrigation, so that conceivably the price might be \$75 or \$30 per acre ON THE SAME PROJECT—the difference being only the number of acres paying the \$750,000 necessary to build that project.

This Water Users Association will use ONE watering plan if the acreage wanting water is small, and ANOTHER if it is large—INITIAL COST is the big item to be considered.

What Is the Most Important Question?

This Association ask you that Mr. Landowner only because its own Directorate and Members who are WATER WANTERS, have had to answer it. They know that if you stop to give the matter your consideration you will arrive at the same answer—because there is only one answer:

Cooperation!

Consider us all! Here we are rubbing elbows with each other, all watching the clouds—mostly dry clouds! Here we are watching the sunlight—and many of us cursing it, our **GREATEST ASSET!** Here we are with Bear Creek, the Applegate, Big Butte, Little Butte, Four Mile and Fish Lakes—all flowing by us—yes! and still flowing by us!
