The defendants blame their proseculion to the alleged machine actions of their political enemies.



SALMON HANDS OF NORTH IN PORT

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 6 .- The San Francisco water front is swarming today with sailors and cannery hands from the waters of Bering sea and its tributaries, who since last Saturday night have been arriving in unprecedented numbers following their five months work in the salmon fisheries of the north.

Nearly 1500 men, it is estimated, have landed from Alaska since Saturday night.

The sailors and fishermen who man the vessels of the salmon fleet are for the most part Scandinavians and Italians. The cannery hands are Mexicans, Chinese, Japanese, Filininos and Hawailans.

Each of the men, it is estimated, will have several hundred dollars when he is paid off, notwithstanding that the salmon run this year i reported to have been smaller than the average.


