To the Tax payers of the City of Medford:

Ladies and Gentlemen,—You no doubt are already interested in and familiar with the proposed re-bonding of the City of Medford for to take up the outstanding Medford Bonds issued under the Banner Act, and to refund to the property owners, who have so willingly contributed to paying the public debt.

Now I would like to call your attention to the fact that this payment is a public debt, and not a private, honest obligation.

The Streets of the City of Medford belongs to the City which the records will show, so does the paving laid on said streets, why contend for one moment, that paying on public property laid for the benefit of the public and used exclusively by the Public, is private property, and that private individuals should pay for same by direct taxation, or special assessments?

The Constitution of the U. S. guarantees equal rights to all and special privilege to none and it also guarantees to its Citizens, property rights and if we do live in Medford, Medford is still subject to a higher law than one laid down by a few to benefit certain classes.

I am informed that the Supreme Court of the State of Washington in a decision rendered some time ago, held that you could not take private property for to pay for public improvements laid on public property.

I am also informed, that this has been the outcome of a number of other suits that have been started in different localities to take some private citizens property for to pay a direct assessment for a public improvement, laid on Public Property, so why should we think for one moment that our Homes or our property would ever be confiscated to pay for Medford Paved Streets? and I here and now Challenge any Lawyer in the City of Medford to start suit in behalf of said City to collect any part of these paving assessment either principal or interest by foreclosing on the abutting property, and I will say right here for the benefit of all concerned that I am most heartily willing to be made the defendant in such a suit and I will furnish the property to be used to test the validity of said assessments.

I might say in conclusion that all three of these men are heavy taxpayers on the Main Street of Medford and will no doubt be called upon to pay perhaps more than all the rest of the Councilmen twice over and still they recognize the justice of the Bonding and refunding plan as submitted by Mr. Medynski and are willing to stand by the principle that has placed such men as Washington, Lincoln and others on the roll of fame.
