

GERMAN TROOPS AT GREEK BORDER; ALLIES REFORMING

LONDON, Dec. 9.—German troops are reported at the Greek border. With the Anglo-French line reforming almost within Greek territory. It is believed here that Greece cannot postpone much longer a more definite revelation of the stand she expects to take should the arena of hostilities be transferred to her soil.

Colonel Phallis of the Greek army is now conferring with the entente commanders, but the Paris press expresses the fear that he is not authorized to take the full steps necessary to safeguard the interests of the Anglo-French troops. The interview given by King Constantine to the Associated Press is attracting a great deal of attention in Germany, where the opinion is general that he has given good reasons in justification of the attitude of his country.

The plans of the French and British troops in the Balkans are still a mystery. The continued landing of reinforcements lends color to the theory that an aggressive campaign is contemplated. At the same time the steady withdrawal of the troops from their advanced positions leads to the belief that for the present the occupation of Saloniki as a base for operations at a later time forms the extent of their determination.

With only three days left for the test of Lord Derby's plan for recruiting, enlistment officers are being overwhelmed with men who wish to volunteer under the group system. Last night many recruiting officers worked until after midnight.

DADDY LONG LEGS COMING TO VINING

The intricacies of theatrical booking arrangements usually work a hardship on a majority of the cities in the west by withholding from them the biggest dramatic successes until the plays have been given in every big city along the North Atlantic coast. "Daddy Long Legs," which comes to the Vining at Ashland, December 14, is an exception to the rule. By entrusting the play, almost from its beginning, to two companies of evenly balanced merit, Henry Miller made it possible for Cincinnati, Cleveland, Detroit, Pittsburg, St. Louis and San Francisco to see the famous comedy last season while it was still the reigning success on the New York stage. It will be played here by the same company before it is offered for the first time in Baltimore, Brooklyn, Boston or any other city except New York in the North Atlantic states.

BRITAIN ACCEDES TO U. S. REQUEST

WASHINGTON, Dec. 9.—Ambassador Page at London advised the state department today that Great Britain had acceded to the American protest against requisitioning of ships of the American Trans-Atlantic company.

Test cases will be made of the steamers Hockin and Genesee, which will not be requisitioned, but held pending decision of the prize court. In the meantime Great Britain assures the United States that no other vessels of the company will be seized.

BULGARS CAPTURE SERBIAN VILLAGES

BERLIN, Dec. 9.—Four towns near the southwestern Serbian frontier have been captured by the Bulgarians, the war office announced today. They are Oehrida, 18 miles north of the Greek border; Struga, northeast of Oehrida; Dibra, 35 miles above Oehrida, and Djakovva, over the border in southwestern Montenegro.

LABOR ORGANIZATION OF TWO MILLION MEN

LONDON, Dec. 9.—The largest labor organization in the history of England, representing about two million men, was formed for the purpose of offensive and defensive action in matters affecting wages and conditions of work.
