WASHINGTON, Feb. 19.—A \$2,757,000 emergency appropriation for immediate necessary repairs of machinery in battleships, torpedo-boat destroyers and submarines, to increase the supply of mines and for the first time to equip battleships with anti-aircraft guns was asked of congress today by Secretary Daniels.

WORK RESUMED ON CANAL EXTENSION TO TOLO DISTRICT

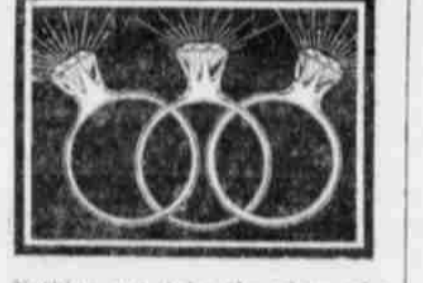

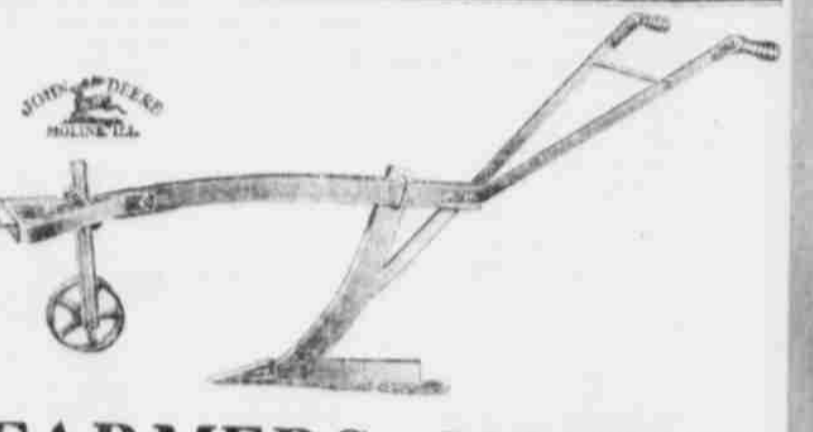
