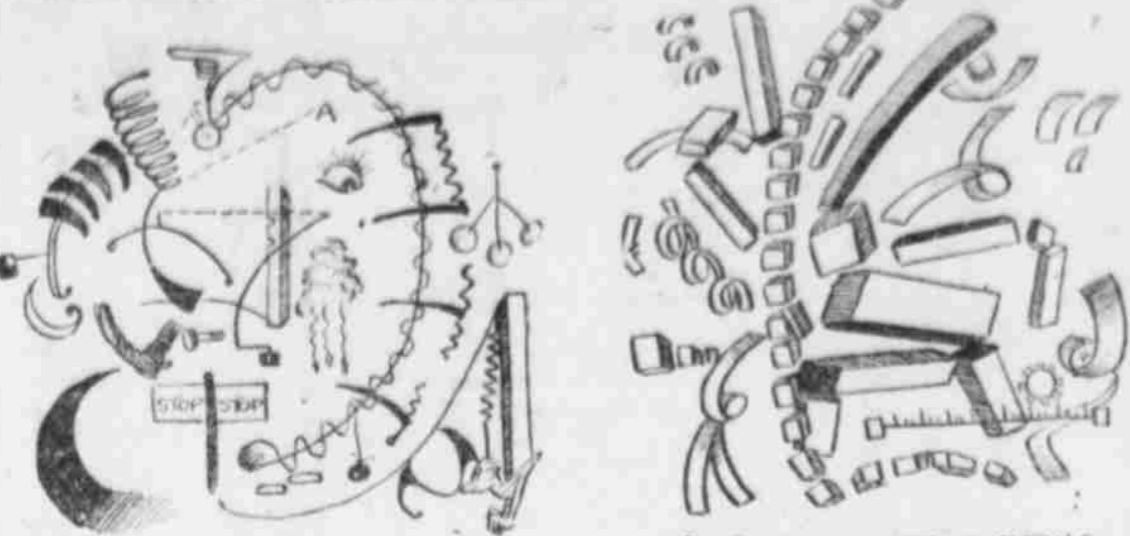


THE MEADOWS

We are just beginning to realize that the Mountain King is not only the biggest quicksilver mine in Oregon but in the U. S. A. The tremendous extent of the ledge which runs several miles north and south through the district proven up now by prospects in several places along its trend makes this one of the most important quicksilver regions of the world. One of exceptional richness has been found in several newly opened prospects north of the Mountain King.

The Mountain King mine furnished the big piece of native quicksilver ore exhibited at the San Francisco fair. It was as large as a water-pail and came from the foot wall chert that has been proven for over 150 feet vertically, over 200 feet of stopping ground. This piece of ore was commented upon by mining engineers as a freak kidney of ore, seldom occurring in such quantities but the permanence of this chert seems to be fully established by later developments. The property covers 929 acres, which would mean 46 mining claims if taken up under mineral locations.
