TRIPLE MURDER IS LAID TO T. R. MORAU

WELLS POINT, Texas, June 8.—R. J. Morau was arrested late today, charged with the murder of his father-in-law, H. F. Goodnight, president of the Vanizant First National Bank and the latter's wife. Mr. and Mrs. Goodnight and Mrs. Morau, their daughter, were attacked early today in their home with an ax or hammer. Mrs. Goodnight was found dead and Goodnight died several hours later.
