A considerable stretch of the rails between Medford and Jacksonville were taken up the past week and replaced with heavier steel. The lighter steel will be used in the construction of the extension. This work will be done by Mr. Bullis without the assistance of the city, pending the settlement of the injunction proceedings brought against the city to prevent the sale of bonds for the construction of the road, which will be heard in the county court next Wednesday and from there will without doubt be carried to the supreme court.

### DISTRICT ATTORNEY WARNS HUNTERS
