

### JOHN HAMMERSLEY, MISSING HUNTER, ALIVE AND WELL

John Hammersley, missing government hunter, who was thought yesterday to have been the victim of a pack of timber wolves, is alive and well and killed a cougar last Saturday, according to a message he telephoned to Dr. William P. Chisholm at Gold Hill this afternoon. Hammersley telephoned from the ranch of Hiram Moore on Willow Flat.

This morning two men left Wimer for the scene of the tragedy on Upper Evans creek. They were followed this afternoon by Mrs. Hammersley, who left Grants Pass in an auto. Hammersley was informed of this fact and will meet his wife and the other searchers at Willow Flat and will proceed with them to Evans creek, where the party will endeavor to establish the identity of the skeleton found Sunday by a party of timber cruisers.

Hammersley had been in the mountains since January 2, and his failure to send word to his wife of his whereabouts led her to believe that an accident had befallen him.

The timber cruisers who discovered the tragedy left everything undisturbed and the signs will be plainly read by the members of the party when they arrive.

### MEXICANS RUSH WORK UPON CODE

QUERETARO, Jan. 29.—On the recommendation of Foreign Minister Aguilar, the constitutional assembly today withdrew for re-consideration and amendment article 3 of the new constitution, which was under consideration. The provision of this article regarding which the foreign minister addressed the assembly and the revision of which he recommended was that requiring foreigners to renounce nationality and treaty rights insofar as they affected property they wished to acquire, before they could acquire it. The discussion was suspended for an hour while the committee withdrew for amendment of the article.

The assembly planned a continuous session from 3 o'clock this afternoon until midnight of January 31 for the completion of its work. The only measures remaining for consideration are the articles dealing with the expulsion of foreigners and the acquisition of land by foreigners and that providing army re-organization, together with some minor matters still requiring attention.

### ASHLAND DEFEATS COTTAGE GROVE

After defeating Medford in a return game on the local floor, the Cottage Grove basketball team went down to defeat at the hands of the Ashland Coast Artillery team last Saturday night, the score being 28-8. The artillery team has defeated the Ashland high school aggregation 24-25.

Medford will meet the Friday night Ashland artillery team next Friday night on the local floor. The game is arousing much interest, as it will afford a means of comparison as to the relative strength of the Medford and Ashland teams. If Medford puts up a good game against the soldiers, it will mean that she has a relatively good chance against the Ashland high team.

The artillery team is composed of high school stars of former seasons. They have played together for the past three years without a change of lineup and are considered one of the strongest teams in the southern part of the state.

### HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES DECREASE

According to figures compiled by the county clerk, there was a distinct falling off in the sale of fishing and hunting licenses during the year 1916 from the figures of the previous year. During the last year hunting licenses to the amount of \$2190 were sold; fishing licenses \$1722; combination \$504; non-resident hunting licenses \$40. Sixty-six combination licenses were issued without charge to Civil war veterans. The total sale for 1916 was \$4466. The sale in 1915 was \$5154, or a loss for the past year of \$688.

### MOVE LAUNCHED FOR ADVERTISING MINING RESOURCES

A large and very enthusiastic meeting was held at the library last night the object of which was to form an organization to exploit the copper and other mineral resources tributary to Medford, and especially the Blue Ledge copper district. Also to promote an educational and advertising campaign of the same.

Dr. F. C. Page called the meeting to order. H. C. Garnett was chosen chairman and H. A. Latta, secretary.

**Work is Outlined.**  
A motion was made by A. S. Bliton that a transportation committee be appointed. This was seconded by E. H. Hurd, the motion carried and the chairman will select the committee later.

E. W. Liljegrain gave an illustrated talk on what was accomplished, under adverse circumstance, in the Rossland, British Columbia mining district and compared the same with what could be accomplished in the Blue Ledge district.

Mr. Jeldness, a prospector for 16 years in the Blue Ledge district, told of the wonderful ledges of copper from 50 to 200 feet in width, which can be traced for miles, on both the Oregon and California sides.

Dr. Page told of the work among a few enthusiastic citizens to get this movement started and to arrange for displays of copper ore in the stores, for an advertising campaign and to prepare data pertaining to the mineral resources.

**Necessity of Roads.**  
Vernon Vawter called attention to the necessity of putting the roads to the Blue Ledge in shape for auto trucks to bring the ore to Medford and said one of the officials of the Blue Ledge told him the amount of ore brought out would depend on the condition of the roads.

E. M. Brown, of the Roguelands company told of his experiences in different mining districts and said development of mines would build up a community quicker than anything else excepting oil.

Henry Callaghan, one of the prominent prospectors in the Blue Ledge district, said we have at our back door one of the greatest copper districts in the world and all that was necessary to put Medford on the map is to go after it. He told of the rich ore blocked out at the Gray Eagle and Happy Camps that is waiting for transportation. He also spoke of the rich by-products in the districts.

**Mine to Co-Operate.**  
J. W. Dressler said the meeting was a splendid success in every way and read the following telegram from D. C. Brown, manager for the Towne estate:

### FOUGHT TWO YEARS AGO FOR \$9; NOW RATED WITH CHAMPS

A boy who two years ago fought for \$9 and two weeks ago received \$400 for his end of a bout is now a factor in lightweight circles and his demands will run well into four figures for future ring engagements. It took Willie Jackson less than three minutes to hurdle into fame. Unknown, picked as setup for Johnny Dundee, this frail-looking

youth in less than one round accomplished what no other lightweight has been able to do—win over the sturdy Italian by a knockout. Not since Young Corbett came out of the west and sent Terry McGovern to the canvas for the count has there been such a sensation in ring circles as that produced by the one-round victory of the New York Hebrew.

And for those who would discount the victory by the lucky punch theory, there is this to remember: For several years Johnny Dundee has been fighting the best of the featherweights and lightweights and in that time has assimilated numerous heavy punches on his jaw. The general result was that Dundee came back and fought all the harder.

### GERMAN RAIDER WELL EQUIPPED STATE PRISONERS

PERNAMBUCO, Brazil, Jan. 30.—From information gleaned from survivors of steamers sunk recently in the south Atlantic by the German raider, it has been learned that the raider was a vessel of the merchant type, about 300 feet long and with parts of her sides movable. She had two telescope masts, two telescope funnels, a false hand steering gear on the poop deck, which concealed her largest guns and four concealed torpedo tubes.

The steamer it is said, mounted four six-inch and two seven-inch guns, including several of the machine type. She was equipped with ventilators and was of the fruit rarrying type of boat, her between-decks space giving accommodations for many prisoners.

The captain of the raider, according to some of the men brought here, informed a captured British officer that he was not interested in passenger boats. He sought only cargo boats he said, as he had no accommodations for women and children. The raider frequently was repainted and had on board sufficient material completely to change her appearance.

There is a disagreement among the men landed as to whether the raider is armored. All of them agree, however, that the raider is thoroughly equipped and no detail in this respect has been overlooked. As an example, they say, each prisoner on board the raider is furnished with a bit, hammock and blanket.

The prisoners are kept in the hold behind iron doors. Enemy prisoners, it was stated, were allowed an hour daily for exercise, while neutrals who wore white bands on their sleeves were granted greater liberties.

MEXICO CITY, Jan. 22.—It has been reported to the war department that bandits tried to cross from the United States into Mexico today near Brownsville and were forced back by troops under General Ricaut.

General Ricaut reported that American troops were pursuing the bandits on the American side of the line.
