DANIELS AND BAKER WOULD CLEAN UP CAMP MORALS

WASHINGTON, May 6.—Broad authority to protect the morals of soldiers and sailors was requested of congress today by Secretaries Baker and Daniels. Secretary Baker wrote to the senate military committee, asking extension of the law permitting him to clean up immoral resorts within restricted zones.

PART OF THE PROPAGANDA.

THERE is good reason for believing that the socialist party was one of the devices of the German government to spread organized discontent and create anarchy among the nations of the world, so that when "the day" came, they would fall easy prey to the German military machine. Of course the danger lay in the socialists of Germany growing strong enough to overthrow the home government—but the German autocracy, knowing the docile and obedient nature of its feudal-minded subjects, realized there was little danger on that score.

The socialist doctrines were promulgated in Germany and the socialist propaganda in every country has known organized and conducted by Germans. The organization of the party in America betrays its origin, as it is fundamentally autocratic. Any member who fails to accept the edicts of the ruling cliques, always pro-German, is summarily ousted. The native socialists attracted by the utopian theories of universal brotherhood, were simply dupes.

Since the war, the socialists in every country have aided and assisted Germany in her fight against human liberty. In Germany, socialists heartily supported the war of conquest, "Internationalism" was shown to mean "Deutschland oder alles"—one nation and that Germany. In Switzerland, in Italy, in Sweden, in America, everywhere there is a socialist organization, it has worked in behalf of Germany—prated of a peace that could only mean a German peace and sought to create discord and divisions in the ranks of Germany's enemies.

In Russia alone has the socialist plan "made in Germany" succeeded—and what the socialists have done to Russia, they would do the rest of the world. In Russia Germany realized—and Russia left helpless as German prey—as America will be if socialists succeed.

In the United States, practically every patriotic American has been read out of the socialist party or left in disgust—leaving only the kaiser's agents and their doctrinaire dupes. Those left in the socialist party are still loyal to the kaiser, doing his dirty work—back door enemies of the nation.

In Wisconsin last month Victor Berger, born in Austria, under indictment for sedition, ran for United States senator as socialist candidate on a platform demanding the recall of American troops from France and immediate peace. In Illinois, the socialist party has declared for constant opposition to the war, for immediate recall of troops from abroad, and demanded that the president demand a peace conference from the peoples of warring countries and execute a peace—the peace of Russia. The national socialist party has promulgated the same platform.

Those who now constitute the socialist party are as disloyal and traitorous to the United States as their brother socialists, the I. W. W., and should have the same treatment.

THE BARBARIANS.

DISPATCHES from Paris state that the hospital established near the front by Dr. Alex Carrel of the Rockefeller institute, has been persistently bombarded by German aviators and now is almost entirely destroyed, despite the fact that it constantly flew a flag bearing a huge Red Cross and was further identified by an immense white cross marked on the lawn. This has forced the installation of the hospital in the suburbs of Paris, where it will be a mark for the German long range guns.

Hospitals and hospital ships have been special targets for the Huns, and also take great delight in shelling Red Cross ambulances picking up the wounded. Bombarding of famous old cathedrals, the priceless memorials of medieval art, showed the Germans had no respect for religion. Belgian atrocities proved his hate of humanity. Poison gas and liquid fire, Zeppelin raids and U-boat destruction all attested the ferocity of the finer instincts, and proclaim the unfettered spirit of the ruthless barbarian.

Germany's great contribution to the world is the renaissance of barbarianism, called "Kultur," which has united the free peoples of earth against her. As Augustus Thomas well says:

That part of the world which really stands for civilization is resolved at last that the vision of mankind must not be blinded; that the aspirations of the human soul must not be extinguished by a bloody and rapacious barbarism, whose egotistical contribution to mankind has been the sausage, that carnivorous discovery that refuse meat may be deceptively embalmed in larders of linked intestines.

An Appeal to German-Americans

Frederick Beier Sr. of Rugby, S. wants to farm. If I stayed over there D. writes the following message to German-Americans in the Pierce County Tribune:

To all people of German blood who live in this state or elsewhere in the United States, whether you are citizens or have intended to become such, I have a few words to say about what our duty is in this war. I feel that it is my duty to say a few words to the Germans for two reasons. One is because I am a German, born in West Prussia in 1869 and lived there until I was 21 years old, so I know something about the fatherland. The other is because I am now a citizen of the United States and have not forgotten my oath of allegiance which I swore as soon after coming here as I could get my papers. Also I see what my duty as a citizen is and want to do it as far as I am able.

One of the first questions I am often asked by people, "Why did you leave Germany?" Well, that is not hard to answer. My father was a poor man with nine children. He only owned seven acres of land. It was hard to make a living for us all and there was no chance for me to get any part of it when I was grown up. It was not like in this country where nearly every farmer can spare and to start his boy out with it he

there that amounted to anything, was a good common school education but there was no free higher schools and no chance for a poor fellow to better himself.

I was one of those who emigrated to the United States and I have never been sorry that I did so. Instead of being proud I am glad I came and I am proud to let it be known that I am as true an American citizen as I know how to be. Why shouldn't I be glad to be? Why shouldn't I be glad to have had to offer me alongside of what America offers? I am not the biggest man in this country, far from it, but I am an independent American citizen. As long as I am honest and tend to my business I am equal to every man here. I don't have to take off my hat to any man unless I want to and the men in this country who are big, meet me on equal footing.

Instead of being a poor laborer in Germany I am the manager of a good, sound business institution here and myself and my family are happy and reasonably prosperous. The other business men, no matter what their nationality or business, treat me with respect and as an equal and my family enjoy the same social advantages that theirs do.

When I look around me and see what a lot of German people there are in this country who are worth many times what they would have been worth if they had stayed in Germany, and I think about these free homesteads that were given them and of the free schools and of the right we have to vote and be part of the government, and when I think of all the freedom we have here and did not have there—and when I read the papers and see what is going on over there now and what I would have to take part in if I was over there and not here, in ask my brother and sister Germans living here to consider all of this and if you haven't fully decided to stand by America as a true citizen should, that you do so now and forever.

Our plain duty lies in supporting this government that has given us homes and protecting us and our families. We must do this not only by words, but by actions as well. We must not be Germans at heart and Americans on the outside. We must not secretly rejoice when Germany wins a battle. We must not stand with one foot on one side of the line. We must get clear over on the American side and stay there. We should be glad we are free Americans. No one will blame us for being sorry for the stain that has been put upon honest German blood by the Prussian power but our won't be honest blood unless we back up our oath of allegiance by our sympathy and love for our adopted country. If we won't be honest about it then we should go back and never let it be said that German blood is two-faced.

We know that Germany is fighting for conquest. We know that America stood out as long as it could before going to war. We know that Americans have always fought for Liberty for all the people and when we read how the United States is today fighting and spending large sums of money for the little down-trodden nations that they, too, may be free and independent just as we are, who wants to go back?

Before the war, our German children here were spoken of with pride. We have been thrifty; we have been honest. We have worked hard and prospered. If we are loyal Americans we can still hold up our heads and people will respect us. So let us stand up for this government. It is now our government. It needs our time and money and we must give just as other citizens give and maybe more, because we know better than others do what this free country really means to the free people as a people.

As to our boys fighting against their own blood, we can reply that fighting against its own blood is what makes America the land of the free today. Didn't the first settlers in the new England states fight their own blood when in the Revolutionary war they shipped England? And they whipped her because on this side they fought for freedom. When this country went thru the Civil war did not brother fight brother, and father fight son? And wasn't it freedom and liberty they fought for then? And can't we now see that their fight was a good fight and that right won?

If the freedom which we enjoy now has been bought with the blood of thousands of liberty-loving men and years of strife are we who come here and share it without one cent of cost to us, going to fight against it, now, when it needs us? If we do, we are surely traitors and never again can we claim to be honest men and women.—Frederick Beier Sr.

SCHOOL SURVEY MOST BENEFICIAL AT CENTRAL POINT

The benefits of a school survey by the public nurse have already been demonstrated in Central Point, according to a communication sent by E. B. Stanley, principal of the Central Point schools. Three children were found nearly blind in either one or both eyes, and others suffering from headaches caused by defective vision, none of whom realized the cause of their troubles. Tuberculous and are being treated by the public nurse.

Miss Allen has, with one exception, examined every child in this school. We were not especially surprised at the number of children whom she found to be physically defective in one way or another, but we are surprised and, at the same time, pleased with the success which she has been having in getting the parents to cooperate.

A small percentage of the children in any school will be found to be in such a condition physically that it should be a criminal offense to let them go without the needed medical attention. This school has proved to be no exception to the rule. Miss Allen found as many as three children who were nearly blind in either one or both eyes—a condition which can be remedied by wearing glasses. More than a dozen others have poor sight and are suffering, more or less, from headaches or other nervous troubles. Several have their throats filled with rotten tonsils or adenoids, which make them mouth breathers, which condition causes many other troubles. Two of the children are in the first stages of tuberculosis.

A large percentage of those found defective have already received medical aid and show great improvement in their school work. I am bringing this matter to your attention at this time because I am convinced that few people, other than teachers, fully realize the value of the work of a health nurse. The better informed people have their children properly cared for and take it for granted that others do the same. The less informed do not know the necessity of such care so their children have to suffer as a result.

The loss ultimately falls upon the state and county in maintenance of poor farms, hospitals and penal institutions. It also lowers the standard of our citizenship.

I believe that the children who are growing into the ranks of manhood and womanhood should have the advantage of careful medical inspection as do the boys who enter the ranks of the army.

What the nurse has accomplished here in the case of any one of several children is worth all that it has cost to keep her during the time she has been here. I therefore urge that the county court seriously consider the matter of providing a permanent county health nurse.

DRYEST OF SEASONS INCREASES CHANCE OF FOREST FIRES

On account of the early dry weather several forest fires have already occurred in this vicinity due to the burning of brush areas or washings when no fire trail had yet been made around the area to be burned to prevent the fire from spreading. We have one case in mind where forest officers and a crowd of men put in a whole night going to and fighting a fire which had spread over a good sized area. It cost money and labor, all of which might have been saved for a better purpose if only a little foresight and judgment had been exercised by the party who started the fire.

If every one having a slashing to burn in or near the national forest will report it in advance to the Forest Service office, Federal building, Medford, phone 236, some one connected with that office will gladly cooperate and give all the assistance possible. Anyone having a slashing not near the national forest will be rendered similar assistance by state or county forestry officials if they will request it. W. T. GRIEVE or Lincoln McCormack of the Jackson County Fire Patrol association.

Due to the fact that the smoky atmosphere renders it difficult to see a small smoke any considerable distance it has been suggested, and is urgently requested, that every person appoint himself or herself a committee of one as lookout man, woman or child, and if a fire is sighted telephone the Forest Service office at Medford, phone 236, or the district ranger, or lookout man in your vicinity, give the location of the fire as nearly as possible, your name and phone number. In addition to this, if a small fire is seen near where you are go to it at once and corral it by scraping a good trail around it which will prevent the fire from spreading. If the fire is on the steep hillside make it the upper side of the fire first, corral it so there can be but little or no chance for the fire to jump the trail. After a trail a foot or so wide, all scraped to the mineral soil, has been made around the fire it may be necessary to dig a sort of ditch along the lower side of the fire to catch burning chunks, cones, etc., that might roll down. On fairly level ground one can easily handle a small fire if there is not a strong wind blowing.

A few days ago a little five-year old boy spotted a forest fire and reported it at once with the result that the fire was put under control in only a short time. Every person intending to enter the forests and who expects to build camp fires, and every one living in or near the forests, who wishes to burn slashings, etc., may save himself

These laws are written in a little booklet, vest pocket size, and should be read by every Oregonian living in or near the forests, or contemplating a trip into the woods. The booklet contains also extracts from the Oregon game laws. Any one may get it by writing for a copy to F. E. Elliott, State Forester, Salem, Oregon or copies may be had at the U. S. Forest Service office, Federal Bldg., Medford.

It has been found necessary to require users of some of the national forests to get permits before building camp fires. It is hoped that it will not be found necessary to pass such stringent regulations over our forests in southern Oregon, for many of us enjoy a short trip into the mountains where, at present we are free to roam at will thru the wildwood as long as we recognize and respect the rights of others and our duty as good citizens.

ALLIED AIRMEN DESTROY 23 GERMAN SUPPLY BOATS

AMSTERDAM, May 6.—The effective work of allied airmen in harassing the German supply service, is described by the newspaper Les Nieuwvellen of The Hague, which says that allied aviators recently sank in one day twenty-three Belgian boats laden with gravel and road metal for the German front in Picardy.
