The government has appointed the Jackson county chapter of the Red Cross, whose headquarters are in Medford, as the central point for the gathering of the pits and shells for all southern Oregon, and Mayor Gates, as chairman of the Red Cross chapter has appointed N. S. Hernett to have charge of both the local and southern Oregon gathering and ship-\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* ping. The Bardwell Fruit company warehouse will be the storage point for shipment and headquarters. All All plts and shells will be delivered there. The government has already sent 100 bags to be filled, and more are coming. All the Red Cross auxiliaries will

have charge of the gathering in their respective communities, and the school pupils of the city and county will assist in the gathering. Details will be announced later, but it is known that barrels will be placed at each school house in which to tome the pits and shells, which must be dry. Arrangements will be made inter by Mr. Bennett for the gathering up of fresh walnuts and other nuts. There must be a gas mask for every soldier. Carbon is needed for gas masks for our boys at once.
