PAPER SCARCE; PACK FOOD IN POCKETS

It will be a common sight to see father, either with his pockets bulging with potatoes, turnips, meat, bread and the like, or parading himself daily with a big market basket loaded with such trash. This is because of the scarcity of paper, for which reason the United States food administration has taken a hand and is seeking to have the grocers of Oregon save on paper. The food administration is going to handle the paper situation something like sugar is being handled and grocers will only be allowed to use so much paper a month in wrapping up packages. The administration has been busy recently signing up the Medford grocers to cover pledges. The Oregon state retail merchants and grocers' association has sent out the following instructions to grocers: "Wrap no food except those that have to be wrapped for sanitary reasons and then use as light a cover and as small an amount as practicable. Encourage the use of market baskets."
