GERMAN AGENTS ORGANIZED THE U. S. SOCIALISTS

U. S. Soldier Testifying in Trial of Victor Berger Declares the Socialist League Organized by Herman Basler—Dissemination of Notices of the Socialists.

CHICAGO, Dec. 13.—Direct examination of Private Arnold A. Schiller, soldier at Camp Grant, former socialist and first government witness, was resumed in the trial of Victor Berger and four other socialist leaders charged with conspiracy to violate the espionage act.

Schiller, a former distributor for the American Socialist, edited by Wm. F. Kruse, one of the defendants, was questioned by Assistant District Attorney Joseph B. Fleming. The witness said that he bought a map of Texas in preparation for a trip to Mexico after Herman Basler, described by the witness as a "German agent" and city organizer of the Young People's Socialist League, had told him of a secret route to Mexico.

Discussing a visit to the office of Adolph Gerber, one of the defendants and national secretary of the socialist party, after his induction into the army, Schiller said:

"I had on my uniform and Mr. Gerber jokingly remarked, 'has one of the 200,000 coffins the government has ordered been measured up for you?'"

Schiller described a motto of the girl's of the Young People's Socialist League which read: "The hand that holds a musket can never hold mine."

"Mr. Kruse showed the motto to me," he said.

Liberty Bonds for Slavery

Excerpts from the Socialist Bulletin of June, 1917, which pamphlet the witness said was given to him in the presence of Victor Berger in the socialist headquarters, were read by Mr. Fleming to the jury. One of the excerpts was labelled advertisement, and read:

"Buy a Liberty bond. Get a real one. The bankers' bonds are slavery bonds and will bind you to Morgan's wheels. Buy a defense fund bond."

FLU CASES SHOW STEADY DECLINE LAST FEW DAYS

According to the daily reports of Medford doctors to City Health Officer E. B. Pickett, the flu epidemic in the city is steadily declining. On Wednesday last 52 new cases were reported, on Thursday, 26, and Friday at noon only 10 new cases.

No deaths from the disease were reported Friday although C. B. Watkins, the local cobbler was reported very low and little hope for his recovery was entertained. Mr. Watkins has been critically ill with pneumonia for several days aggravated by serious complications.

The flu mask regulation is now being scrupulously observed by the people of the city there being no arrests today, although a few business men neglecting to observe the regulation in their stores were warned by the police.
