URGES INCREASED RATES OF INTEREST FOR LIBERTY BONDS

NEW YORK, Mar. 28.—United States Senator William M. Calder of New York, announced here today he had written a letter to Secretary of the Treasury Glass, calling attention to depreciation of recent issues of Liberty bonds and urging the secretary to call President Wilson advising that a special session of congress be called at once so that the situation might be remedied.

Senator Calder expressed the opinion that unless this was done it would be impossible to obtain popular subscriptions to the forthcoming loan, thus necessitating the taking of bonds by the banks, a situation which would, he wrote, have the effect of limiting credit for general business, with injurious effects upon the country.

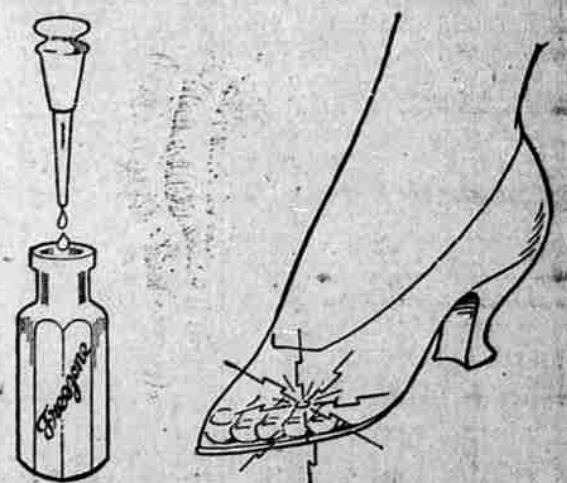
