

PORTLAND MAN SPEAKS IN FAVOR COAST HIGHWAY

S. C. Pier of Portland, delivered an interesting and convincing address at the Commercial club luncheon at the Hotel Medford this noon, in favor of the Roosevelt highway which will be voted upon at the election June 3d.

Mr. Pier, who is a well known Portland business man, proved to be quite an effective orator and combined hard common sense with an appeal of an altruistic nature. After pointing out the commercial advantages of the proposed highway the speaker emphasized the need of aid for the people of the Oregon coast who under present conditions find life scarcely worth living and contact with civilization almost impossible. Instead of interfering with tourist travel on the Pacific highway, Mr. Pier declared the construction of the new road would increase it and by the inevitable construction of laterals would open up the entire state to business and commerce.

There were over 30 members present at the luncheon, the speaker being introduced by Secretary Steel. Judging by the reception given Mr. Pier the members of the commercial club are strongly in favor of the measure.

STOP WATERING LAWNS UNTILL FURTHER NOTICE

The fire whistle was blown this noon not because there was any fire in the city but to cause water consumers to at once shut off irrigating their lawns and gardens. And until up to late this afternoon the siren whistle had not been blown again signifying that the "fire was out," and may not be blown until sometime tonight or Wednesday.

This peculiar situation was brought about by the fact that the city water department began cleaning out the reservoir this morning and thru some oversight the public was not notified beforehand, as is customary on such cleaning occasions, to not irrigate lawns and gardens. The reservoir was emptied and the city's water supply came from the intake pipe direct. Hence to maintain as large a pressure as possible as a fire precaution the fire whistle was blown.

It usually takes from one to several days to clean out the reservoir, and people are warned not to turn the water on lawns or gardens again until notified thru the Mail Tribune.
