

WHY INCREASE IN MEDFORD SCHOOL BUDGET IS MADE

According to members of the school board the large increase in the 1919 budget is due principally to a necessary increase in teachers' salaries. Higher salaries are being paid for teachers all over the coast and if Medford is to maintain a respectable standard they must be correspondingly increased here. The 1919 budget provides \$61,485 for teachers' salaries, an increase over 1918 of \$14,485. Included in this increase is \$3,500 due to the flu epidemic, which required an extended teaching period.

Other increases are mainly due to the increased cost in all materials, fuel, supplies, etc. Janitor salaries have been increased \$700 a year or \$1,700, fuel \$800 or 63,000, and as insurance premiums fall due this year another \$500 has to be added, to this item, making a total of \$700.

Necessary repairs for school house are placed at \$4,000, grounds \$800, library books \$800, furniture \$1,000, improving grounds \$800, playground equipment \$200, supplies \$800, payment of bonded debt and interest \$6,000.

In the opinion of the members of the school board the added expense for 1919 is essential to the proper administration of local schools and they feel that the people of Medford can not make a better investment than by thus improving the quality and standard of the city schools. According to the school board the expenditures can not be reduced without lowering the efficiency of school administration.

HARRY STOECKMAN IS SCHOOL CANDIDATE

Interest in the annual school election which will be held next Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the high school building is increasing. At this election the voters will vote on the school district tax budget and elect one school director.

Harry G. Stoekman announced his candidacy Thursday for director, and the announcement was greeted with general favor throughout the city. He is the only candidate so far mentioned.

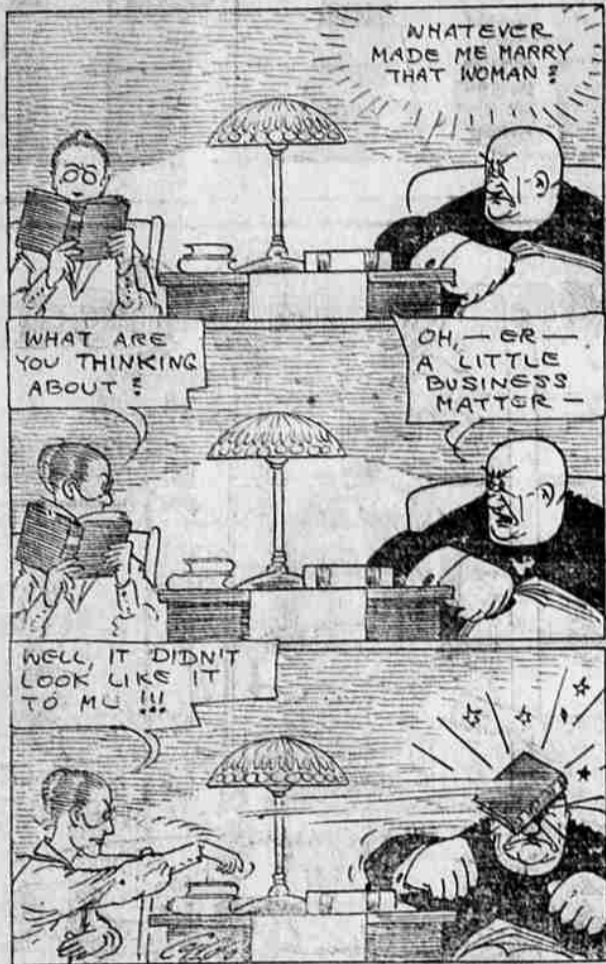

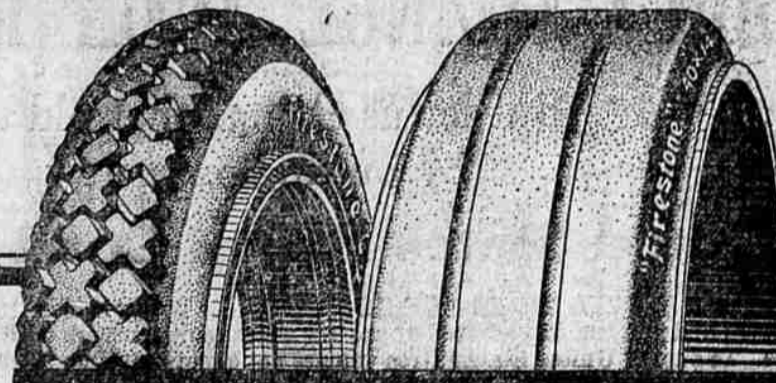
