

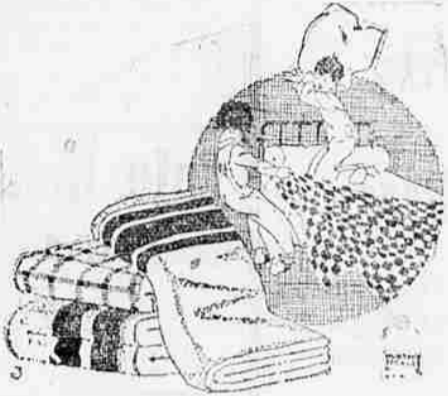

EXPLANATION OF SABBATH IS MADE BY EVANGELIST

A good sized congregation was out last evening to hear Evangelist Rippey on the sealing message of Revelation 7. A few moments were spent in a review of the last evening's service, bringing in additional evidence to show that it was the Papal power that changed the day of worship from the seventh day of the week. He read from several Catholic catechisms to prove his statements.

It was made very clear that at the council of Laodicea 336 A. D. the change was made. He read a statement from Cardinal Gibbons showing that the change of the day of worship from the seventh to the first day of the week was the mark of the Catholic church's ecclesiastical authority in religious things.

Rippey showed that the whole world bowed down to the Catholic church in the observance of the first day of the week as a day of worship, since there was not a word in the Bible authorizing the change, to which the Catholic church frankly admits.

The evangelist stated that God was sending a message to the world calling the people back to the Bible and keeping a day that was set apart by God. He then read in Rev. 14:1-5 that the redeemed from the earth would have their Heavenly Father's name written in their foreheads. He then turned to Rev. 7:1-4 and showed that there was a sealing message to go to the world, sealing the people of God in their foreheads, (or minds). He stated that since the Father's name was written in the forehead and in as much as the seal was placed in the same place, the Father's name must be in the seal. The meaning of this seal in the forehead was the receiving of this seal in the mind, accepting the seal by faith, as the seal of the living God.

He showed from Rev. 6: that the message of the seventh chapter following the falling of the stars in Nov. 12, 1823 was to prepare a people for the coming of Christ and that it is due to us today. "A seal, sign, or token are synonymous terms," said the speaker, and are always connected with law." (See Gen. 17:11, Rom. 4:11, Dan. 6:8, 1 Ina. 2:18, Ester 3:12, 8-10.) In Isa. 8:16 we find that God's law has a seal in it and that according to Dan. 7:25, Isa. 24:5,6, and Eze. 22:16 that the seal had been torn from it.

A seal must have three requisites, name, authority and territory. After reading the ten commandments which is God's law, the Evangelist showed that the fourth commandment was the only one that pointed out who the God was that gave the law, declaring Him as creator. The fourth commandment has been removed from the decalogue and people are holding to nine commandments and thus adopting another day of worship which has been set apart by the Papacy. The Lord is now sending a message to the world to bind up the testimony and seal the law among his disciples, and thus placing the commandment back where it belongs. Under the new covenant the law of God is written in the heart or mind, before it can be written there as a whole it naturally follows that the seal or fourth commandment must be reinstated.

The speaker said he did not wish any one to take his word as to the fourth commandment being the seal but that he would read it from the Bible. He then read Ex. 20:1-14, and Eze. 20:12, 20 to prove that the Sabbath was the seal of the living God, and that Sunday was the mark of the Papal power. Tonight he will speak on the true Sabbath of the Bible.—Adv.

CHICAGO, Jan. 22.—Chicago school teachers, who yesterday appealed to the board of education for a sixty per cent wage increase, will receive a blanket raise of \$100 to \$200 per year, George P. Arnold, chairman of the board, announced today. Representatives of the teachers indicated they would accept the award as temporary relief but would continue their fight to get equal to that of common laborers. At present the teachers receive considerably more than little minded teachers, the instructor claim.
