PRESENT MEDALS OF WAR AT PAGE THEATRE FEB'Y 22

Engraved memorial certificates, significant of France's gratitude to America, will be presented to the nearest relatives of all Oregon boys who died during the world war in the uniform of their country.

France selected the American Legion as the representative of this country's fighters and the agency through which the delivery of the memorials should be made.

The army recruiting office at Portland is receiving the memorials for this district. As soon as complete lists of soldier dead have been compiled and checked over, the certificates will be turned over to state headquarters of the American Legion at Portland and from there sent directly to local posts.

Relatives of boys who made the great sacrifice have been requested to turn in their names to the nearest post of the American Legion, with their address or place they can be found on February 22. Local lists will be submitted in duplicate to state headquarters. Every effort is being made to have the lists complete and correct as possible that no one will be overlooked.

Memorial programs being prepared in honor of the young men are under local post direction, committees having been appointed to arrange the details.

The memorial certificates are the work of Franklin Booth, an American artist, and are commemorative of the service of the American doughboy, gah and leatherneck in the greatest of wars. Each is inscribed with the name of the dead fighter whose nearest of kin receives it.

An effort will be made to have the presentation program at the Page Theater Washington's birthday, February 22.

APPRAISERS FOR CALIFORNIA LAND BANK HERE SOON

The California Joint Stock Land Bank of San Francisco have received such a number of applications for farm loans thru their local correspondents, the McCurdy Insurance Agency, that they will have appraisers here within a few days. Although applications have only been taken in Medford the past few weeks, the loans if accepted will bring thousands of dollars into the valley.

Joint Stock Land banks are different from Federal land banks in that they can loan at present from \$1000 to \$37,500 to one individual, and the applicant need not be an actual farmer. The money may be used for any purpose the borrower desires. Appraisals are made by the McCurdy Insurance Agency first, and later by appraisers sent here direct by the bank.

The loans may run from five to forty years at 6 per cent interest. The funds of the California Joint Stock Land bank are practically unlimited, hence the representation of this bank in Medford will undoubtedly prove of great value to the community.
