ENGLAND FEARS INVASION "VULGAR" AMERICAN SLANG

LONDON, Feb. 7.—England is apprehensive lest the vocabularies of her youth become corrupted through inroads of American slang.

Trans-Atlantic tourists in England note with interest the frequency with which resort is made to "Yankee talk" by British song and play-writers seeking to enliven their productions.

"The child at the pictures is picking up a new language from the slangy American film," says a critic in a contribution to the London Daily News headed "The Vulgar Tongue."
