GRAND JURY ON RECORD FOR GOOD RD. BOND ISSUE

Hon. F. M. Callans, Circuit Judge:
We, the grand jury, make the following report: We have found 11 true bills and one not true bill, besides considering several other cases. We made an examination of the poor farm and found that it is in a generally satisfactory condition. Would recommend the purchase of two 75 foot lengths of fire hose and the putting in of a fire plug on the second story; would also recommend the putting in of a new storage house and fire escapes from the second story.
We examined the jail and found it in good condition.
Examined the county offices and found them managed in a business like manner, but all short of room. We recommend that some arrangement be made for the construction of additional storage room for books and records.
In our visit to the county court's office the question of roads for the county was under discussion and the majority of the grand jury favored the passage of a new law raising the state bonded indebtedness from 2 per cent to 4 per cent and such other measures as may be necessary for the carrying out of the legislation for new roads.
A majority of the jury would also recommend a bond issue for \$500,000 in the county to assist in the construction of roads to Crater Lake from Medford and from Ashland to the county line over the Green Springs mountain and from Medford to Rialto in the Applegate section. We make this recommendation at this time from the fact that we are able to secure state and federal aid in the construction of these roads to a great extent.

CITY WORKERS ARE GIVEN PROTECTION UNDER STATE LAW

The city council last night voted to place all employees of the city in the police, fire, water, street and road departments under the workmen's compensation act with the State Industrial Accident Commission. The cost of this insuring the employees against accident will be about \$45 to the city and the councilmen unanimously regard as wise the expenditure of this money in protecting both the city and its employees.
The insurance on the local employees will go into effect about March 1. The highest liability paid by the commission under this act is \$72,500 a month in case of death by accident, and the benefits paid for the various grades of accidents depend on the regular pay drawn by the man so injured from the city. Each city employee, under the law, must pay a cent a day into this insurance fund, which money goes to the state.
