DEVELOP JACKSON COUNTY.

EIGHT per cent on your money isn't bad. Of course 10 per cent is better. But what about 100 per cent and escaping the income tax and excess profits tax in the bargain?

Sounds suspicious. But it isn't. Every resident of Jackson county will have a chance to get 100 percent interest in one year, by voting for the \$500,000 good road bond issue, this May.

For this bond issue as tentatively arranged will be expended on only one condition, that every dollar spent by the county be matched by a dollar spent by the state or the federal government.

That's fair, isn't it,—and also profitable. The value of the Pacific highway has sufficiently demonstrated the value of good roads to render any of the hackneyed arguments unnecessary.

The government has agreed to aid in building forest roads, the state has agreed to aid in building post roads, and state feeders. All the people of Jackson county need to do, to secure a permanent highway down the Applegate from Jacksonville, one from Ashland over the Green Spring mountain road to Klamath and one from Medford to Trail via Eagle Point is to vote for this county bond issue and vote for the state increase from two to four per cent.

True good roads are high, but here is a chance to get them at exactly half price,—a chance that may not be repeated soon if the present opportunity is passed by.

Jackson county has the reputation of being the best good road county in the state. The state good road program started here, and here good road boosters always find their strongest support.

Time to Spray for Peach Curl

Peach growers should spray their peach trees and other stone fruits as soon as possible now for peach leaf curl. This is very easily controlled if the spray is put on before the buds start in the spring.

The best material to use for this work is Bordeaux Mixture. Use five pounds blue stone and five pounds quick lime to fifty gallons of water.

make this Bordeaux Mixture always add the lime and blue stone to the spray tank in one stream, as it will mix better this way than any other way.

When peach trees have been winter-killed this spray will be very beneficial at this time, for many of the shoots that died back from winter kill will be affected by a saprophytic fungus that becomes more or less parasitic as time goes on.

When you can slack the lime and after it is thoroughly slacked, fill this barrel to 50 gallons making a hundred gallons in these two barrels. Then pour each of these into the spray tank at the same time and add another 100 gallons of pure water.
