

INFLUENZA RAVAGES CHINESE PROVINCES

HANGTUNG, China, Jan. 26.—The influenza epidemic in this district has caused so many deaths that there is a shortage of coffins and their price has risen 400 per cent in recent weeks.

Because of this many bodies have been buried in shrouds only, a practice uncommon even among the poorest Chinese. Another detour that has been forced upon the people by the existing situation is that Feng Shui, or the practice of geomancy in connection with funerals by which grave sites and times of burials and other details are determined, is being ignored for the first time, for no longer can notice be taken of lucky or unlucky days for holding funerals.

Whole households are being wiped out by the epidemic.
