A Drugless Flu Treatment

It is a well known fact that fear is the forerunner of many diseases. The recent publicity given the "flu" without at the same time submitting sufficient preventives or a treatment of the disease, has developed in a great many minds a state of fear which is not conducive to good health.

The Bureau of Human Welfare, Beverly Hills, Quacktown, Tex., says in reconstruction that one of the most successful treatments that has been employed and that which a successful physician has treated more than any other without a doubt, is as follows:

Preparation—Cut an orange in half and discard the juice, and the place with a glass of cold water and drink several times every day in three hours.

Preparation—Take a quart of water, add a teaspoonful of salt, and a half ounce of soda, then use as an inhalant, inhaling, when you cough, and use a dry inhalant.

Preparation—Capsicum is ordinary red pepper. Take one grain every two hours during the early stage.

Preparation—During the early stage the patient should sit on the sofa well covered with blankets, and use hot water in hot medicinal water or five minutes at a time, several times a day.

Preparation—in some cases the condition of the system was found to be very bad. In these cases one-half a teaspoonful of bicarbonate of soda (plain baking soda) was added to four ounces of water, this used as an enema, but retained instead of passed out.

Pain—In case there is severe pain, especially over the back, hot compresses should be used, if the patient lives in the country. If in the city, cloths are to be wrung out of hot water, placed over the area of pain and an electric pad placed over the cloths and kept on until relief is obtained, then sponge with cool water and covered well with blankets. (A very hot water bottle may be used in place of the electric pad.)

Abnormal Temperature—When the temperature reached 102 or more a tepid bath, followed by a rub, was given.

Pneumonia—The greatest fear of all has been pneumonia, yet where this very simple treatment was followed there was not a single death.

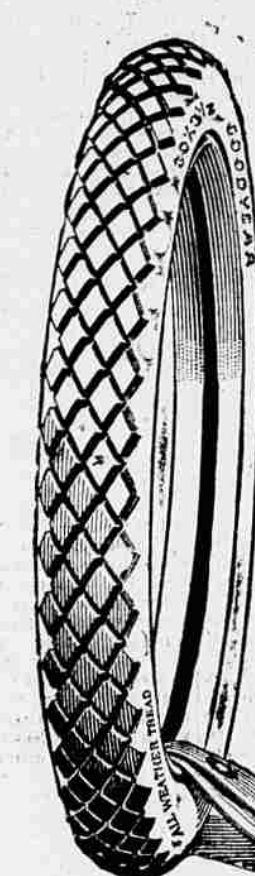
Chop or grate onions very fine, mix with less than an equal part of rye flour and make into a poultice. Apply over chest in form of poultice and over this an electric pad. A simple treatment but wholly efficient.

Cough—In cases where the cough is sub-acute, a mixture of equal parts of lemon juice and honey, well mixed. A teaspoonful every hour or two proves successful. When the system is super-acid, equal parts of orange juice and honey well mixed. A tea-

spoonful every hour or two will bring similar results.
