FIGHT IS STARTED TO DECLARE WAR WITH BOSCHE OVER

WASHINGTON, April 8.—Declaring that the war with Germany was over and that congress must assert the fact, Chairman Campbell, of the rules committee opened in the house today the fight for adoption of the joint resolution declaring the state of war at an end. The debate will close late tomorrow to be followed by a vote.

The first phase of the battle began on presentation of the special rule limiting debate to nine hours. Four hours were allowed for discussion of the rule, the vote on which will give the first test of strength.

Mr. Campbell said the people were wearied by a year and a half of life under an executive with war powers in time of peace and longed for the freedom of a government with three separate and independent branches.

Passage of the resolution, he continued, would put the United States back on a normal basis. He added that grave domestic questions made the proposed action imperative.

"The war is over," he declared. "That is known by everyone. Congress is therefore within its rights in declaring a state of war no longer exists. Autocratic war powers are galling to a free people in time of peace. It is the duty of congress to withdraw from the president the powers granted to him for war purposes. We take no powers from him that belonged to him in time of peace."

"No one has suggested a possible justification or excuse for resuming a state of war with Germany or for continuing war powers in the president. He is left with the utmost freedom to negotiate a treaty with the advice and consent of the senate, as provided in the plain terms of the constitution."

Representative Pou, North Carolina, ranking democrat on the rules committee, made the first address in opposition to the resolution, which he characterized as "the peace humbug to be debated for two days." Passage of the measure, he declared, "would be playing Germany's hand."

Mr. Pou charged that the republicans were seeking to make political capital for the next campaign and were offering the resolution as an excuse for broken party pledges. Howls from republicans greeted his statement that the measure was designed to embarrass President Wilson and they were renewed when he said the president "had no selfish ambitions."

News of the passage by the house of the "miserable, makeshift" peace resolution, he declared, would be more welcome in Germany than any since the announcement of the senate's failure to ratify the treaty.

The resolution is "a business proposition from start to finish," Representative Snell, republican, New York, declared. "It is what the American people demand."

JAPAN GOVERNMENT WOULD CONTROL IN LABOR UNION WORK

TOKIO—Government approval of the organization of labor unions would be given for the first time in Japan under a new bill drawn up by the department of commerce for submission to the present session of the diet. The government proposes, however, to regulate, restrict and to a certain extent, otherwise control the operations of the unions which might be organized under the proposed law. One of the regulations which has aroused criticism provides that when a union or any craft or trade adopts a resolution that runs counter to law or is considered to be detrimental to public interest or fails to perform what is required of it by the administrative authorities, these authorities may cancel the resolution or dissolve the union.

Unions of various trades would be permitted to form a federation of unions only provided its rules and regulations were submitted and approved by "the proper authorities."

Heretofore, Japanese workmen have mostly been organized in guilds, although an associated labor union was in existence in Tokio nearly a year ago. Supporters of the proposed law say the government must take the place of the old guild masters and advise and restrain the workmen until they shall have gained experience in the operations of their unions.

CHINESE RIGHTS TO CZAR RENOUNCED

PEKING, March 31.—(By the Associated Press)—Restoration to China without compensation of the Chinese Eastern railroad and all mining and forestry concessions and privileges seized by the former Russian imperial regime, Alexander Kerensky, Generals Horvath and Semenov and Admiral Kolchak, is announced in a note to the Chinese government from soviet authorities at Irkutsk. The note also renounces indefinitely arising out of the Boxer rebellion.

The Chinese foreign office is not inclined to take the communication seriously, doubting the authority of the soviets to make renunciations.
