

VIOLET HENNING IS ATTRACTIVE STAR IN TONIGHT'S PLAY

(Lean Cass Baer in Sun, Oregonian) Violet Henning, who has been playing here the past week in "Three Faces East," is a sort of violet personage, a woody violet, and, while she isn't exactly a wild violet, or, as the small lad said, a frantic flower, when he meant wild flower, she is just as certainly not an exotic hot-house violet. Her eyes are the same purpling blue as the gentle blossom whose name was given her, her voice is full of little lurking laughs and when she converses she has a flattering and fascinating way of looking only at the person she is addressing. It is rather unusual.

Most actresses, when being interviewed, plant themselves near a mirror and never take their eyes off their reflection in the glass. The practice is not confined to actresses alone. Women plant themselves in front of mirrors in elevators and powder their noses or gaze in admiration at their series of double chins or hats while they murmur absently: "Is the beauty department on the third or seventh floor, dear?" In restaurants and hotel dining-rooms the looking glass habit prevails and even along the highways and byways women stop, stare fascinatedly and continue to stare at their mirrored reflections. Occasionally, and only occasionally, is the action justified. It would have been justified if Violet Henning had chanced to peep at a mirror opposite her, but she didn't even so much as glance there. Possibly her mirror told her years ago how very lovely she is, and so she doesn't press the point.

She is English and comes of an old theatrical family, which has helped make history in England's playhouses. Her forebears and forebearesses were among the actors of Shakespeare's day and enjoyed not only a personal acquaintance with the W. K. writer, but were the originals in many of his plays. Her father Alfred Henning, controls two theaters, one in the Isle of Man and another at Portsmouth. Her mother is Mabel Allen, a well-known English actress. In this connection, Miss Henning told of the original production of "The Christian" for copyright purposes in which her mother played the original Glory Quavle. Hall Caine appeared in the play, and Mrs. Caine and Miss Henning's father, The Hemings and Caines are close friends. For that matter Violet Henning has warm personal friendships with dozens of women and men of literary, musical and artistic circles in London and it is intensely a lover of her "ain country."
