

FARM EXCHANGE TAKES POSSESSION PERRY WAREHOUSE

The Perry warehouse fronting on the Southern Pacific opposite the Jackson county creamery on Fir street, today became the home of the Farm Bureau Co-operative association and it will be used for offices and general warehouse purposes. This is one of the most desirable warehouse properties in the city and the Farm Bureau officials are very much pleased with the transaction.

The Farm Bureau will carry a full line of feeds and seeds after August 15. Up until that date poultry feeds and mill feeds will be the extent of feed operations. In addition to these feeds they will handle grain sacks, eggs, veal, poultry, hides and continue the marketing of livestock in car lots.

Edger Johnson, formerly of the Johnson Produce Company, Central Point, will be in charge of the poultry and egg department. Mr. Johnson is one of the best poultry and egg men in the state. He spent several years with Cudahay & Company, both in the east and in California, before coming to Southern Oregon to go into business at Central Point and Medford.

The Farm Bureau is becoming a big factor among the farmers of the United States and it is a credit to the farmers of Jackson County that they are building an organization upon a permanent basis. Agriculture is said to be the backbone of civilization today and the way farmers are leaving the farms to take up more lucrative employment is nothing short of suicide. The American Farm Bureau Federation has a program of work, which if put into effect should greatly improve agricultural conditions over the country and place the profession of farming where it belongs.

FARMER'S WIFE HIKES TWELVE MILES WITH A LOAD OF FIFTY TONS

The development of electric labor-saving machinery for the farm has brought to light some very interesting figures. Take for instance the matter of pumping and carrying water.

For all household purposes such as drinking, cooking, washing, scrubbing, and cleaning, the average farm family will use about 7 gallons per person every day or 42 gallons for a family of six. Now 42 gallons of water weigh 336 pounds and if those 42 gallons are pumped and carried on only 300 days out of the year, it will mean that some one will have to pump and carry 100,800 pounds, or over 50 tons of water every year. Furthermore, if a 3-gallon bucket is used it will mean 14 trips to the well every day, and if the well is 15 feet from the house, this will mean 30x14 or 420 feet daily. In only 300 days this will amount to 126,000 feet or nearly 24 miles.

So the farmer's wife who pumps and carries water for the house walks 12 miles to the pump every year, pumps 50 tons of water and walks 12 miles back to the house carrying the 50 tons of water.

APRIL WEATHER ABOUT NORMAL, RAIN IS SHORT

The April report of the weather in Medford and vicinity shows that there were frosts on the 11th, 18th, 22d, 23d, 24th and 25th and that there was a total of .99 inches of precipitation that month of which the greatest amount falling in 24 hours was .29 of an inch on April 9. The average for April is 1.44 inches, which places the seasonal deficiency 5.49 inches.

There were 10 days with .61 or more of precipitation, 15 cloudy days, 8 partly cloudy and 7 clear. The maximum temperature was 81 degrees on April 26 and the lowest temperature of the month was 26 degrees below on April 23.
