Commencing Sunday, May 9th, 1920 Irrigation Hours will be as follows:

4:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. 4:00 p. m. to 11:00 p. m.

MONDAY, WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY, on the East side of the Streets running North and South, and North side of all Streets running East and

TUESDAY, THURSDAY AND SATURDAY, on the West side of all Streets running North and South, and on the South side of all Streets running East and West.

SUNDAY FORENOON, on the East side of all Streets running North and South, and on the North side of all Streets running East and West.

SUNDAY AFTERNOON on the West side of all Streets running North and South, and the South Side of all Streets running East and West.

Wasteful use of water or USING AN OPEN END HOSE for irrigating will not be permitted.

WATER MUST BE SHUT OFF IMMEDIATELY IN CASE OF FIRE
