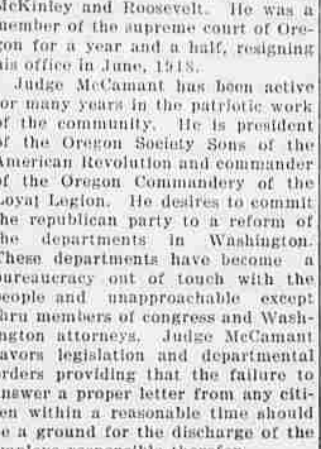

Ordinance No. 1029. AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 883 of the City of Medford, entitled: "An Ordinance to protect and preserve the paved streets of the City of Medford, from damage by heavily loaded vehicles, traction engines and motor driven tractors, and providing penalty therefor, approved May 15th, 1917."

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 883 entitled: "An Ordinance to protect and preserve the paved streets of the City of Medford, from damage by heavily loaded vehicles, traction engines and motor driven tractors, and providing a penalty therefor, approved May 15th, 1917," is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation, to haul, drive, or propel over any of the paved streets of the City of Medford, on any truck, drey or other vehicle, any load exceeding 600 pounds per inch of width of two tires of said truck or vehicle provided, however, that the maximum load shall not exceed 10,000 pounds and provided further that the maximum speed in hauling, driving or propelling over any of the paved streets of the City of Medford any truck or vehicle shall not be greater than 10 miles per hour."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the condition of the paved streets of the City of Medford necessitates immediate protection and preservation and
