Men still have need of Thee.

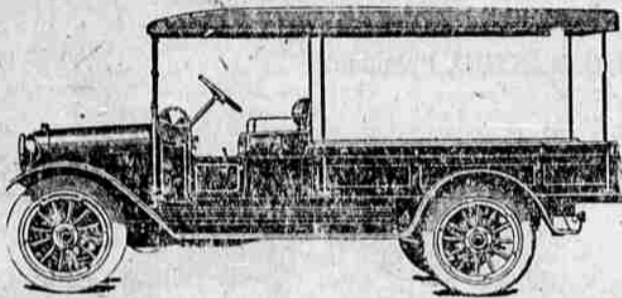
