

### STOLEN BUICK IS RECOVERED AND CROOK CAPTURED

The Buick automobile belonging to the Medford Auto Company, that was secured by a salesman who called himself Arnold R. Carol, has been found at Napa, California. A telegram was received this afternoon by the McCurdy Insurance company from the Auto Theft Bureau giving this information. The telegram read:

"Auto Theft Bureau reports that Medford Auto Company Buick in hands Chief of Police, Napa, California. (Signed) SEELEY CO."

The car was fully insured against theft, and will be returned to this city. The police authorities also telegraphed that Carol had been captured.

Carol posed as a jewelry salesman, and claimed to have closed a deal for the purchase of the Johnson Jewelry store in Ashland. He dickered with the Medford Auto company for several days, and finally gave a check on the Ladd and Tilton Bank of Portland for \$1800, and a note for the balance. He drove the car to Ashland, presumably to close the jewelry store deal, and kept going over the Siskiyou. A telephone message showed Carol had no funds in the bank at Portland, and the hunt started.

A day or so afterwards word was received of Carol passing through Sacramento valley towns.

Wheeler, delegate charged with delivering the electoral vote of the state to Washington, got away today on the first leg of her airplane flight to the national capital. Her first stop will be Omaha, where she will be joined in another airplane by Mrs. Draper Smith, alternate.

Mrs. Wheeler carried the certificate of the electoral vote in an army dispatch case which her son, Mason, now assistant attorney general of Nebraska, used in artillery service in France.

### TWO FIGHT PROMOTERS RETIRE

NEW YORK, Jan. 20.—Withdrawal of two of the promoters of the \$500,000 championship bout between Jack Dempsey and Georges Carpentier would not prevent him filling their places and staging the bout, Tex Rickard, the third promoter declared today. William A. Brady has announced that he and Charles B. Cochran of London, were "through" because "the contracts have not been mutually observed."

### DISARMAMENT UP TO SENATE

NEW YORK, Jan. 20.—Neither Jack Dempsey nor Georges Carpentier, under contract to meet in a \$500,000 championship heavyweight boxing bout next summer, has put up his forfeit money with the depository here. It was announced today by P. J. Fuller, vice-president of the Central Union Trust company.

### WOMAN MURDERESS GIVEN TEN YEARS

OAKLAND, Cal., Jan. 20.—Mrs. Virginia P. Clark was sentenced today to prison for ten years to life for the murder of her husband last August.

### IRISH VIOLENCE FLARES UP AGAIN, SIX ARE KILLED

DUBLIN, Jan. 20.—District Inspector Clarke, a sergeant and four constables were killed and a sergeant and constable wounded in an ambush at 3:30 o'clock this afternoon at Glenwood, near Six-Mile bridge. It was announced by the authorities in Dublin castle this evening.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 20.—A preliminary report to contain conclusions and recommendations, is being prepared by the commission of the committee of one hundred investigating conditions in Ireland and will be issued soon, it was announced today. The report will be based on statements made before the commission, it was said, but the hearings will be continued indefinitely and any new facts developed will be included in an appendix to the report now being prepared.

### ATLANTIC FLEET ARRIVES PANAMA WITH SEAPLANES

COLON, Panama, Jan. 19.—Both the United States Atlantic fleet and the seaplane division attached to it, arrived here today, the seaplanes completing a 700-mile flight from Guantanamo, with two intermediate landings, which was made by only one forced descent. The flyers preceded the warships by several hours. Passage through the canal was expected to be completed Thursday when the fleet will join the Pacific fleet at the Pacific entrance to the canal.

LONDON, Jan. 20.—Alleged Sinn Fein centers in this city were subjected to simultaneous raids by Scotland Yard detectives late last night, says the Daily Graphic. Buildings in both the east and west end, notably in Hayswater, Barnsbury, Paddington, St. Pancras, Eastham, and Hanwell, were raided and it is stated a number of important documents were seized.
