

MYSTERY MURDER-MADISON, WISCONSIN THREE YEARS AGO, TO BE PROBED AGAIN

MADISON, Wis., Jan. 26.—An investigation into the death of Richard S. Lawrence, South Madison broker and jewel connoisseur, who was believed to have had \$300,000 in cash, bonds and jewels in his possession when last seen alive three years ago, has been started by Theodore G. Lewis, district attorney. A fourth exhumation of the body may be ordered in connection with the inquiry, it was said today.
