Whatever is received this week by the Phoenix committee will go to the Hoover Central Europe fund for children, unless the givers specify that it is for China. All who desire to give to the appalling need in China, should mark their gifts "China," and these will be sent at once by the Phoenix committee to the "American committee" for the "China Famine Fund," recently organized in response to repeated appeals from U. S. diplomatic and consular officers in China and from many missionaries who have lived for years in the famine district covering 100,000 square miles and having a population of 45,000,000, who are now almost entirely destitute of food and are trying to live on leaves, bark, etc., and of whom 16,000 are now dying daily. The 15,000,000 will soon die unless America helps them.

Friday has been designated as self-denial or "fast" day in behalf of the starving children in Europe and people in China, and it is hoped that many here will observe it as such. At the soup and bread supper Friday evening at Clyde hall, envelopes will be provided so that all who attend may specify whether they want their money to go to the children of Central Europe or to the people of China or both.

By hearty vote of the congregation present last Sunday morning at the Phoenix church, a special offering will be taken at the church next Sunday morning for the China famine fund.

A tag day campaign in behalf of the Albertina Kerr Nursery Home of Portland will occur on Feb. 12. This is a meritorious institution, its beneficent activities being well known and its needs being championed by residents of this county in general.

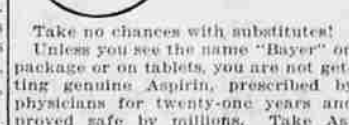
