LAST CALL FOR MEDFORD'S AID TO HOOVER FUND

Unless there is a flood of checks reaching the European Relief headquarters at the Chamber of Commerce rooms tomorrow morning, it will be very evident that Medford is going to fall down on doing its share toward securing the quota assigned to this city.

The names of all who contributed toward this fund during the three day campaign will be published in the Medford Sun next Sunday, unless requested not to mention name. Unless this list comes somewhere, near the amount assigned to Medford it will have an exceedingly bad effect upon the rest of the county where funds are being asked to make up the county quota.

Tomorrow will be the last day of the campaign. There should be no delay on the part of the citizens to make their contribution in order that the money may be sent to state headquarters and from there to national offices where there is an immediate need for funds to carry on the relief work undertaken.

Jackson county must save the lives of 600 children. It will take the sum of \$10 per child to do this. It is a simple question of how many children each citizen is willing to give a chance for life and happiness.

INSPECTION OF NATIONAL GUARD ASHLAND, FEB. 7

ASHLAND, Feb. 4.—The drastic provisions of military discipline are about to be experienced by certain members of First Co., in the event that they do not "tee the mark" by Monday evening Feb. 7, the date of annual inspection by federal officers. The place and hour will be at the armory at 8:30 o'clock, as announced by Capt. Wm. M. Briggs, officer commanding. Specific details are as follows:

Every man will bring to the armory every article of government issue so that it can be left in his locker. Every man who has been recently discharged and who has not turned in his clothing and equipment drawn, will do so at once. If any man who has clothing, whether discharged or otherwise, is out of town, he will either send same by mail to Supply Sergeant Sam McNair, or have his relatives bring same to the armory and receive credit for them. Drastic action will be taken in regard to any discharged man or any other who fails to promptly observe this order.

Every man belonging to the First company, who is in town will be present and have every article of his issued clothing in his possession. No one will be excused from attending this drill unless by reason of severe sickness or absence from the city and this order must be understood to take precedence over everything else and consequently, men who are employed at work which will interfere, will show this order to their employer as sufficient authority for their remaining away from work for the short time spent at the armory. Men will endeavor at once to arrange their affairs in order that they may be present. This is the only time in the year when this kind of an order is issued, consequently, it must be followed to the letter.

Hence it stands, each member to be on the order of both his coming and going. Assembly is announced at 7:30 o'clock sharp, as a preliminary to inspection. Individually the rank and file must appear in spic-and-span condition as regards uniform, equipment, with shoes—preferably of tan texture—shined so that they fairly glisten.

Regular drills have been held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings of this week, resultant fines being the penalty against the men who failed to appear without having obtained a valid excuse, the military code being severe and exacting in this particular.

This reminder is issued in abundant season, in order that all members may be duly notified, several individual units of the command residing outside of Ashland's immediate vicinity.

TALENT LAUNCHES ORGANIZED DRIVE FOR HOOVER FUND

The leading men of Talent met at the city hall last night and laid plans to collect the \$300 assessed to that district. The plans for the Red Cross drives will be followed. Holdridge, Ed Robinson, Mr. Bailey, W. N. Petri, Ralph Koozer, J. A. Hickerdike, Rile Nyswaner, Leonard Oortuys. Solicitors will make returns to the Brown store. It is figured that in order to raise the necessary amount that the amounts given will need to average about \$3 to each family. This will mean that those who are more able to give than their neighbor must do so. For in giving we must not only think to help those who are starving in the far corners of the earth but also of those whom we can assist who live close by. "Do unto others as we would they should do unto us" is the motto of all our orders and churches. Surely we would expect from our fellows that they would be willing to give so small a sum if in the giving we would be saved from starving. Talent has always been in the forefront and the committee believes that the money will be forthcoming. Money is not so plentiful as in former years but no westerner ever refused to divide his loaf. If any givers desire that their money should go to the Chinese people they will so state when making their gifts and the committee will see that it is sent direct to that committee. Forty-five million people in China are starving at the rate of 10,000 per day and the children of Europe are on the ragged edge. America is their only hope. We can give billions to make war, surely we can afford millions to buy peace. Those whom we have helped in their hours of extreme need will not easily be persuaded to take up arms against us. It is good business besides being good Americanism.

All contributions made to the Mail Tribune fund by residents of the Talent district will be credited to Talent's quota in the present drive, as is the case in other districts of the county. Also all contributions to the European relief fund made elsewhere, either to Portland headquarters or to the Literary Digest, will be so credited. In other words the county quota of \$6000 will be reached when the total contributions from every source equal this amount.

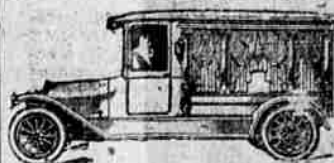
