LONDON.—Excuses offered by women, who for the first time have just been called to sit as jurors in Old Bailey, the world's most famous criminal court, excited a good deal of laughter in that usually sedate place. Twenty-four women were summoned for jury service in criminal cases and mixed juries were formed with, in at least one case, a woman serving as forewoman. The charges included murder, arson and manslaughter.

"I'm too nervous," was the plea of one. "I'm not strong-minded enough," said another. She was excused. Others pleaded inability to leave household, shopping, business, care of babies or sought to evade service on the ground of their own illness or that of members of their families.
