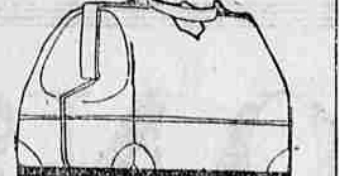
TALENT WILL TRY STAGE COMEBACK AT NAT TONIGHT

The Medford post American Legion basketball squad will meet the Talent team tonight for the fourth game of the Legion-Talent series. Wednesday night, the local boys, through a burst of speed in the last five minutes, broke the tie which was held practically throughout the game and defeated their adversaries by an 18 to 14 score. Tonight the Talent men are out for blood, determined to carry off the final game and locals fans expect a fast, interesting tangle. Tonight's game will afford the last opportunity for people here to witness some of the Medford High team in action since Sherwood, Coleman and Watson, all legion men and members of this season's high school quintet, will play on the Medford legion team. As a preliminary to the main event the Talent high school line-up will mix with the Medford high school team in what promises to be a close, hard contest. A large crowd is expected to enjoy the fine card tonight and the rivalry between the contesting teams will assure them two good games.

SALEM, Ore., Mar. 11.—As a result of bond deals made by O. P. Hoff, state treasurer, with Governor Oicott and William Marshall, members of the newly created state bond commission acting in an advisory capacity, there will be made available for loans to the farmers of Oregon approximately \$164,000 of irrevocable school funds. This sum is in addition to \$60,000 of these school funds recently allotted to 12 counties of the state on the basis of \$5000 each. This money will draw six per cent interest.

BARCELONA, March 11.—(By the Associated Press.)—Delegates of 38 nations attending the international conference on communications and transit in session here were prepared this morning to begin serious consideration of the program outlined yesterday by Gabriel Hanotaux of France, the presiding officer. The most important matter before the meeting was the appointment of a committee to draft a pact relative to transport.
It will be an attempt to settle international controversies relative to railways, waterways and ports.
Regret regarding the absence of delegates from the United States and Argentina was expressed by many delegates yesterday and M. Hanotaux referred to the United States by saying:
"Our thoughts are with the absent."
