LOCAL RED CROSS REPORTS ON WORK DONE THIS WINTER

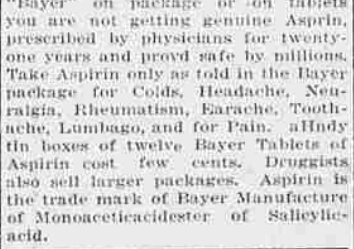
