CHICAGO, April 16.—American pollies, foreign crop reports and grain belt weather combined today to force prices higher on the Board of Trade. May wheat recorded an advance of five cents a bushel over yesterday's closing price and other grains and provisions were pulled along with wheat in the future trading.

There was a regular scramble to buy wheat at the start of the market but professional and trade orders to sell halted the initial advance when May wheat touched \$1.25. Within the next hour, however, the traders heard that official reports indicated the drought in India had wiped out the exportable wheat surplus in that country, that the Argentine crop would be 29,000,000 bushels less than last year's and that a steady drought of six months in France had affected the crops there adversely.

These factors, taken with storm reports and forecasts for freezing temperature over the middle west grain belt in this country, were too much for the bears. They scurried to cover and May wheat went to \$1.27 1/4 a bushel before the movement was checked. Profit taking at that figure then took half a cent off the advance.
