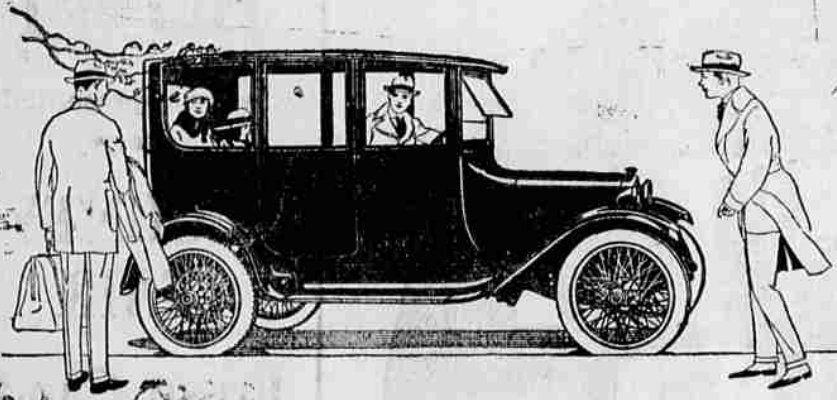

Recent bank statements develop that the First National has \$1,148,832.18 assets and liabilities; Citizens, \$654,646.23; State, \$199,697.83. Collectively they have \$1,972,154.81 loans and discounts, and \$1,028,992.53 deposits. The State bank of Talent has \$134,921.83 assets and liabilities.
