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GREAT REVIVAL EDUCATION IN UNITED STATES

DES MOINES, Ia., July 2.—Pre-eminence among the many factors that should be mentioned in the educational progress of the year is the aroused interest in education itself.

"We might almost speak of an educational renaissance," Mrs. Andrews said.

"Educational leaders have become leaders in educational progress; they have forced the public to recognize the importance of education in a new and different light; they have established the belief that education has social, economic and political value."

"A review of the educational legislation during the past year is a striking evidence of this belief. The country cannot afford not to spend money for the adequate education of all its children."

"The determination to give every boy and girl a chance, to see that the eleven million rural school children have opportunities commensurate with the urban children, is a leading part of the program in this educational revival, and it is the educators who are forcing this problem on the public, and demanding the necessary funds for the realization of their plans, which covers every phase of the educational problem, from the kindergarten thru the university, and they are determined to carry it through. There is a virility in the educational world today that was hardly perceptible five years ago."

U. S. RETURNS MILLION TO GERMAN COUNTESS

WASHINGTON, July 2.—Allen Property Custodian Miller was ordered today by Justice Hitz of the District of Columbia supreme court, to return to Countess Von Bernstorff, wife of the former German ambassador to the United States, bonds and cash amounting to \$1,000,000 which was seized under the trading with the enemy act.

TOKIO WILL SOON BE CITY 7 1-2 MILLIONS

TOKIO, July 2.—If present plans are carried out, Tokyo will in thirty years, by absorption of its suburbs, have a population of seven and a half millions. A circle is to be drawn with Tokyo central railroad station as its center and all towns within a radius of ten miles will be taken into the new metropolis. Twenty-six towns and 56 villages will be absorbed.
